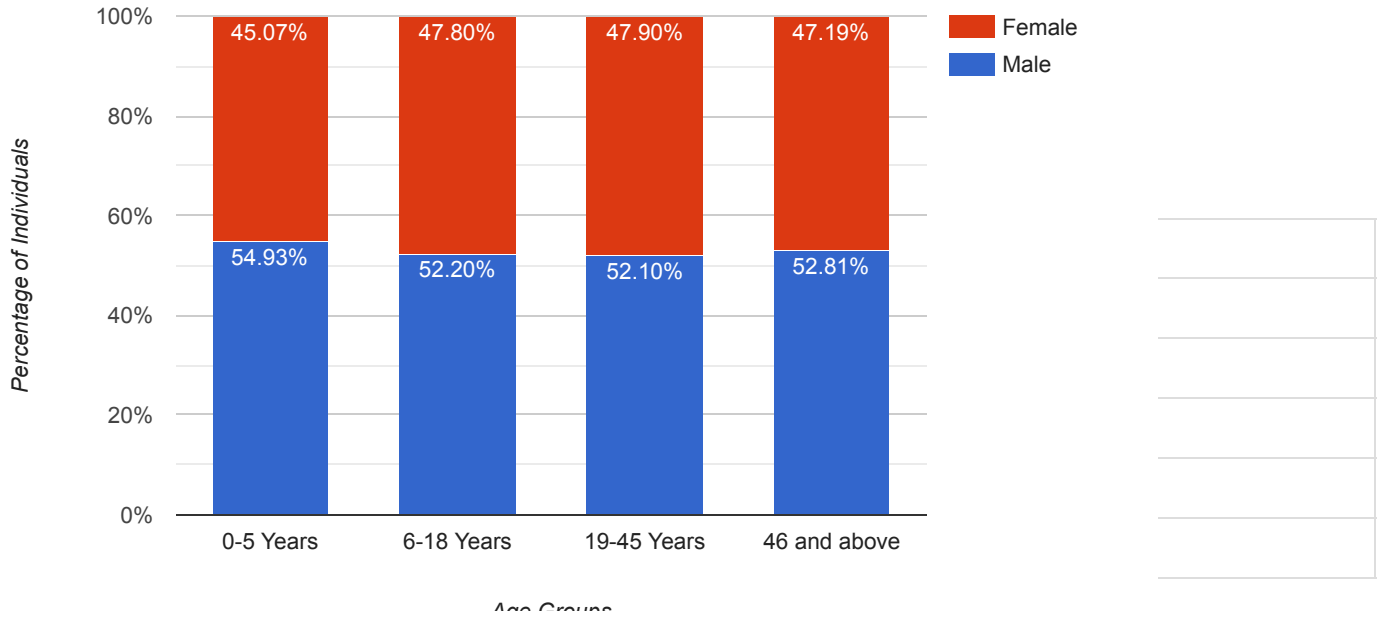

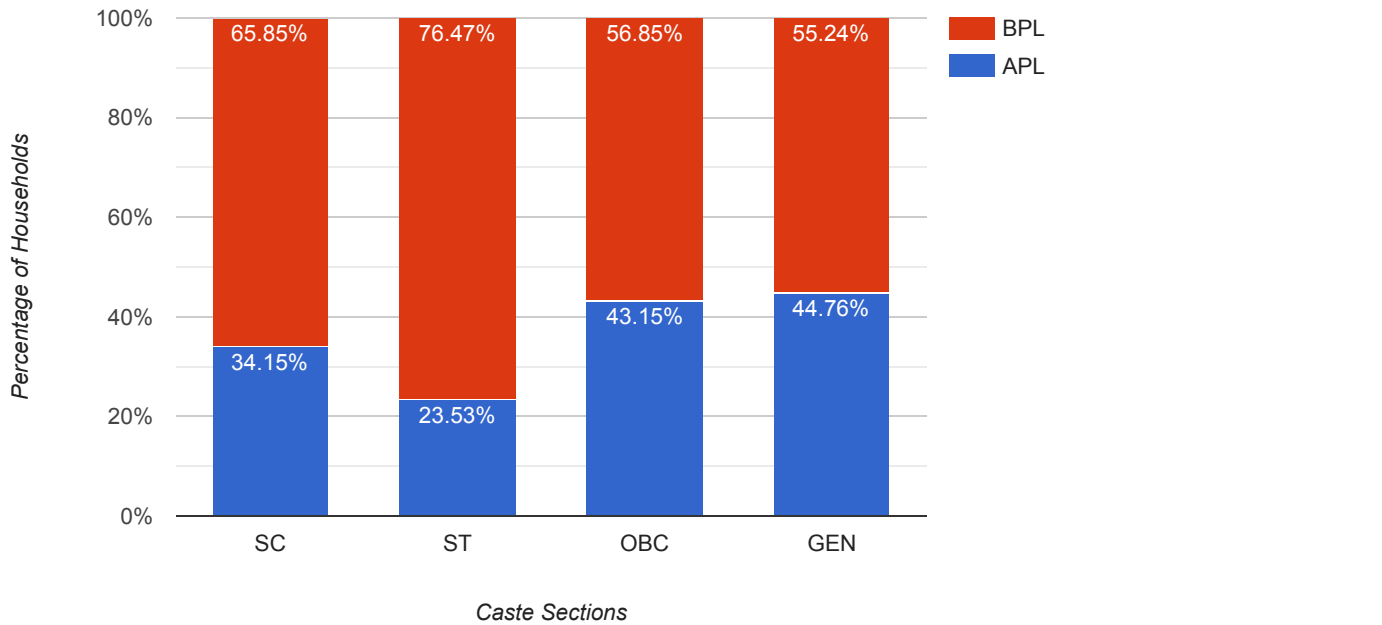

**Gender Wise Population Across Age Groups**



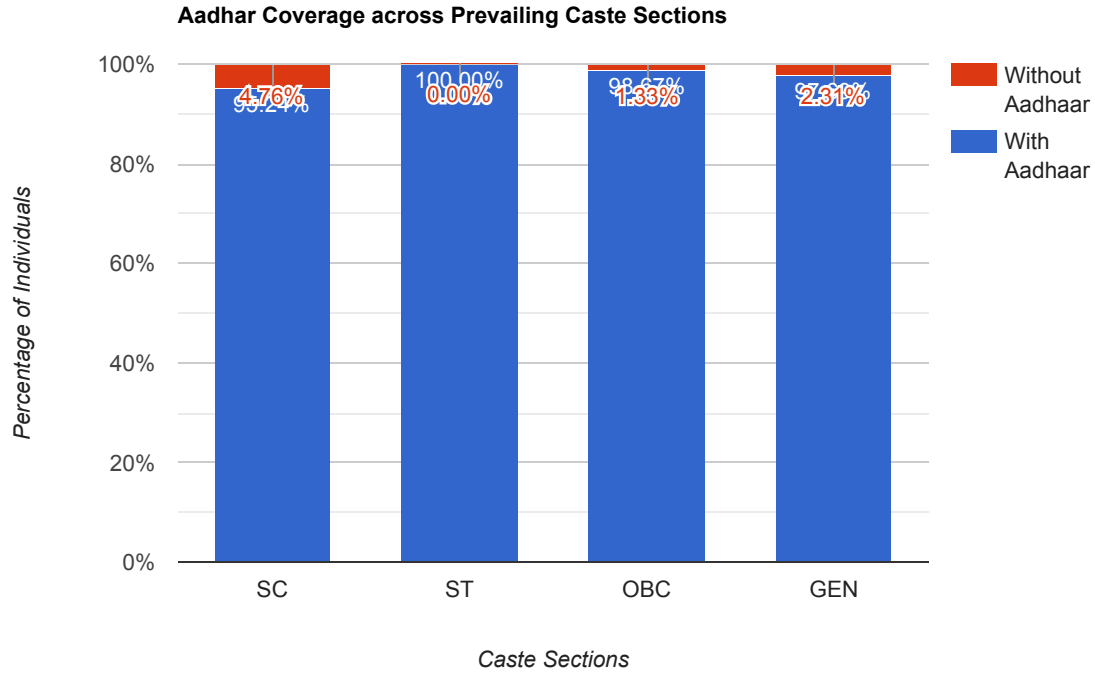
**Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections**

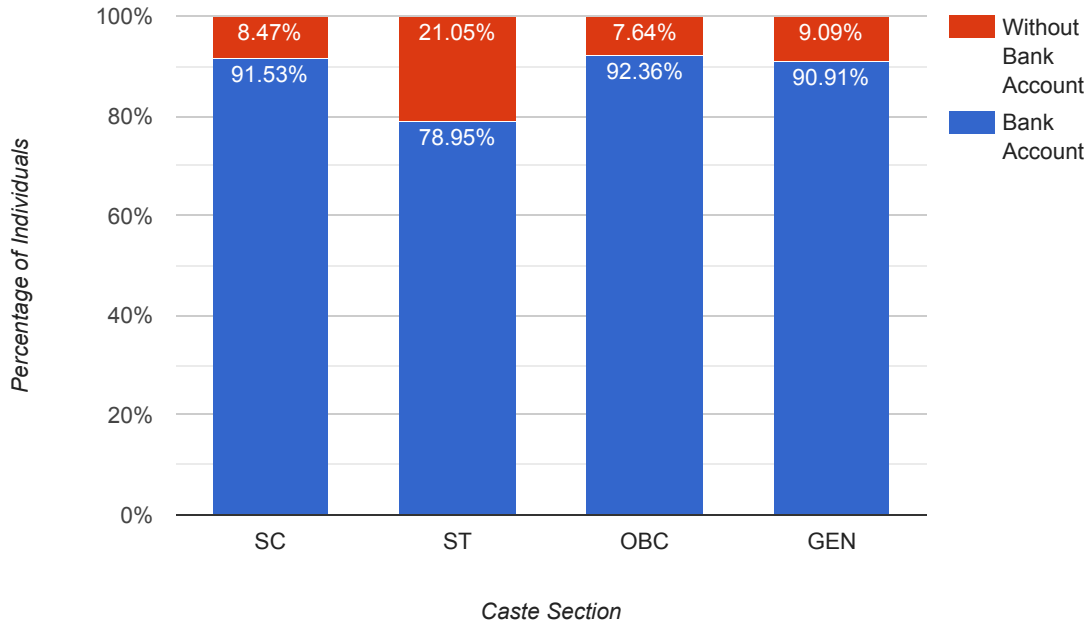

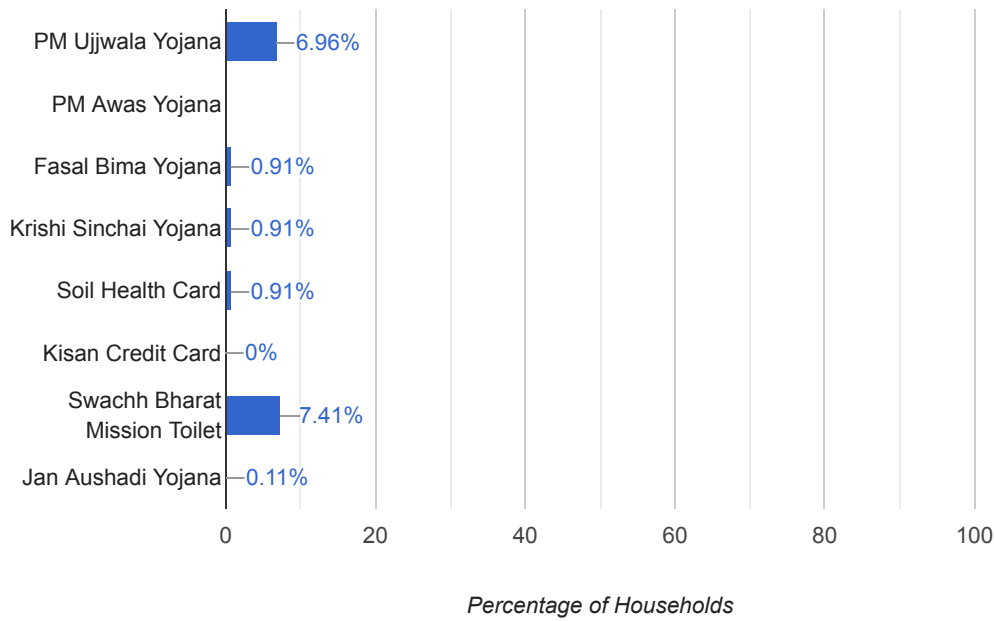

**Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section**



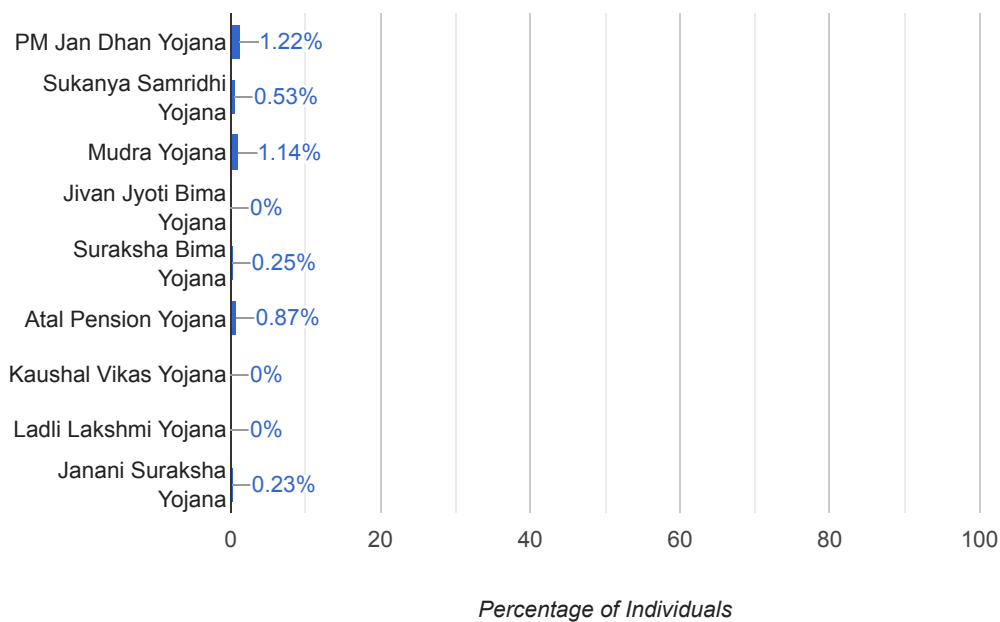

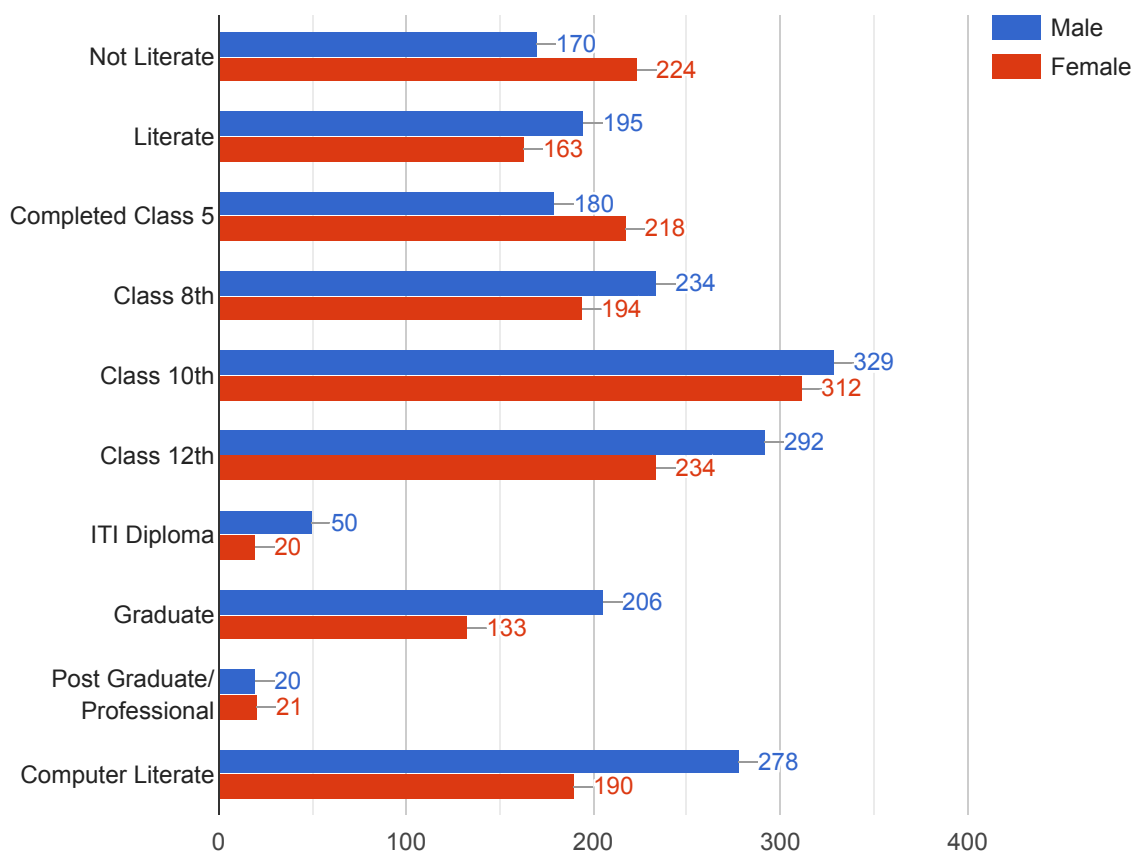

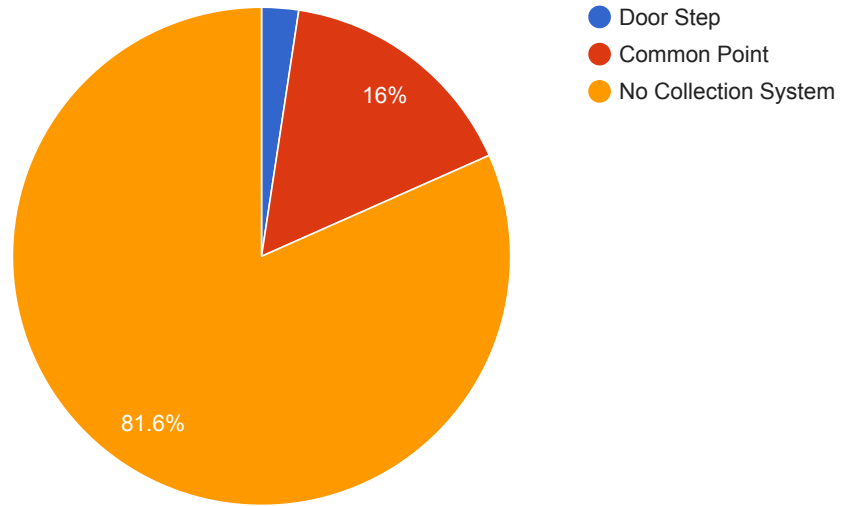

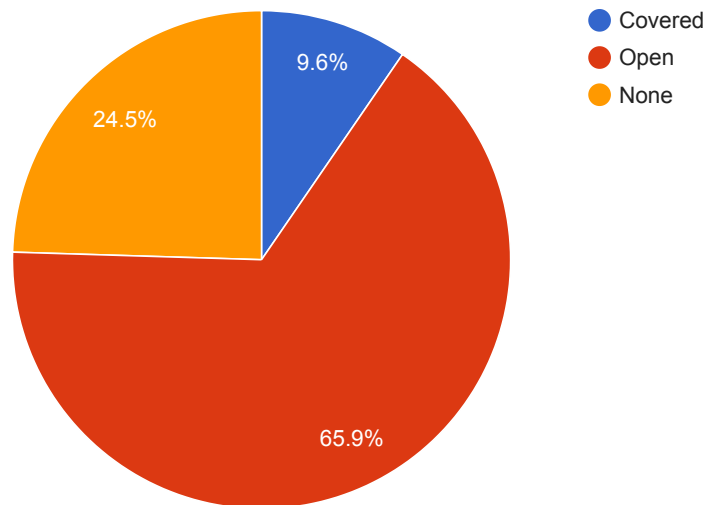

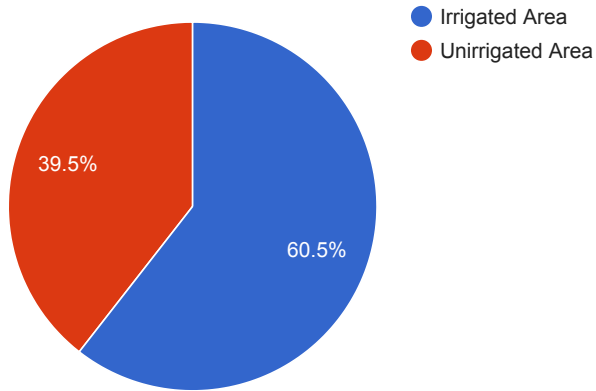

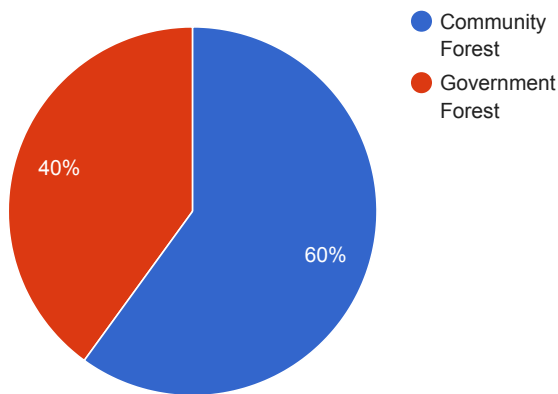
Irrigated area and unirrigated area of total cultivable area

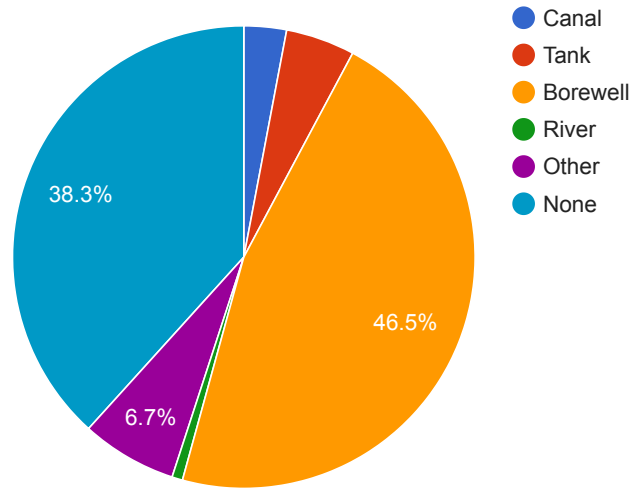

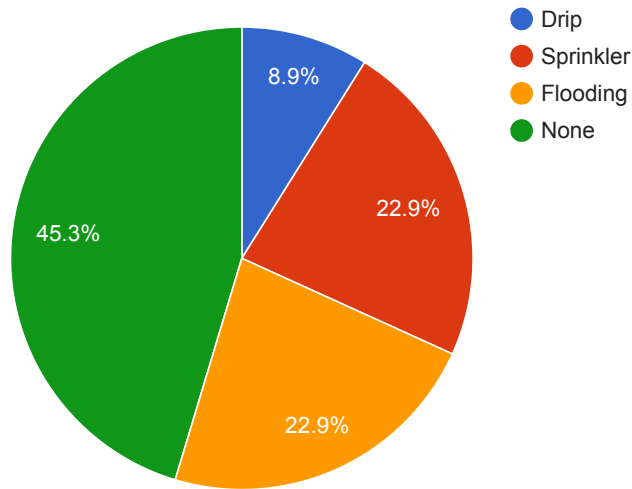

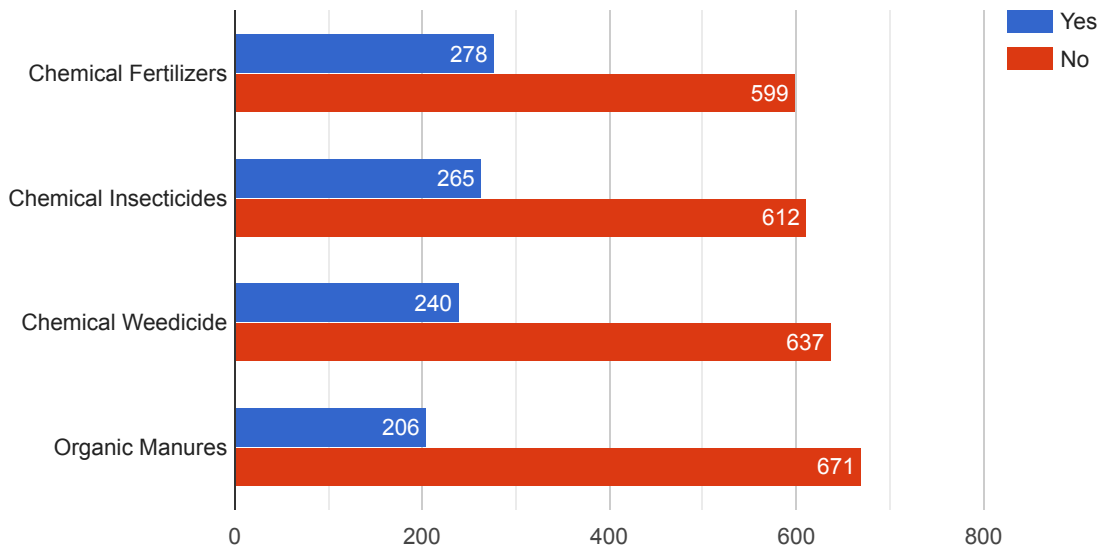

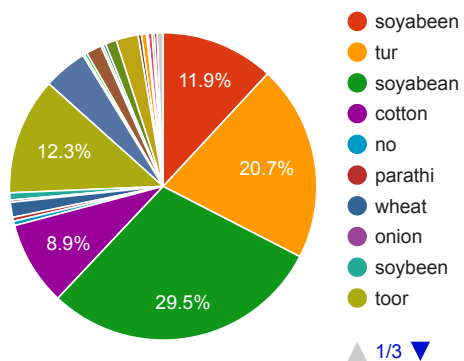

Use of Chemicals and Fertilizers



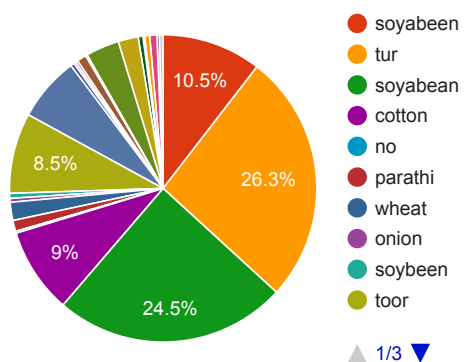

Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops

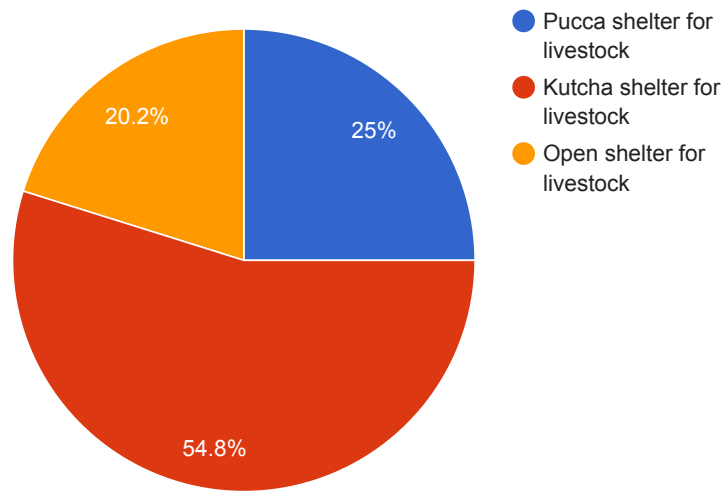

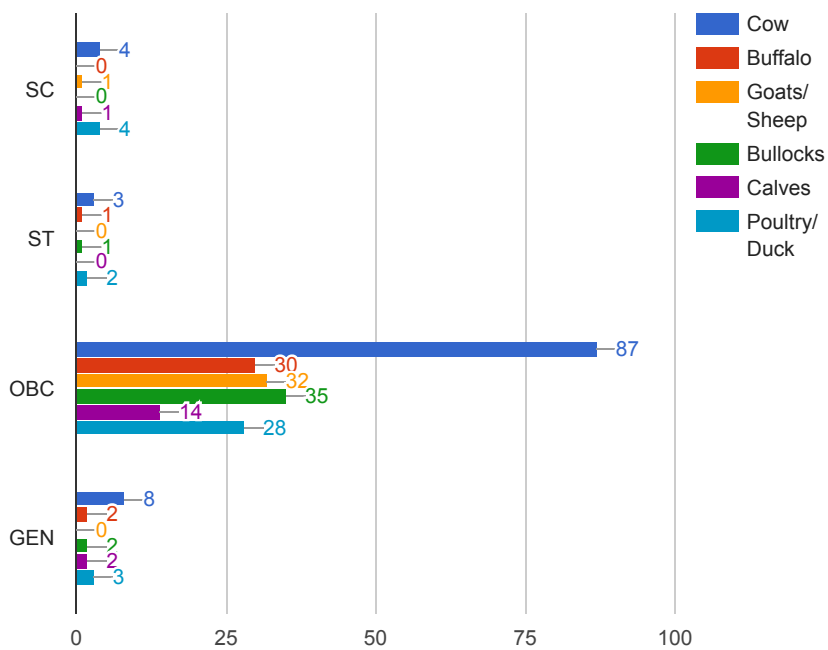

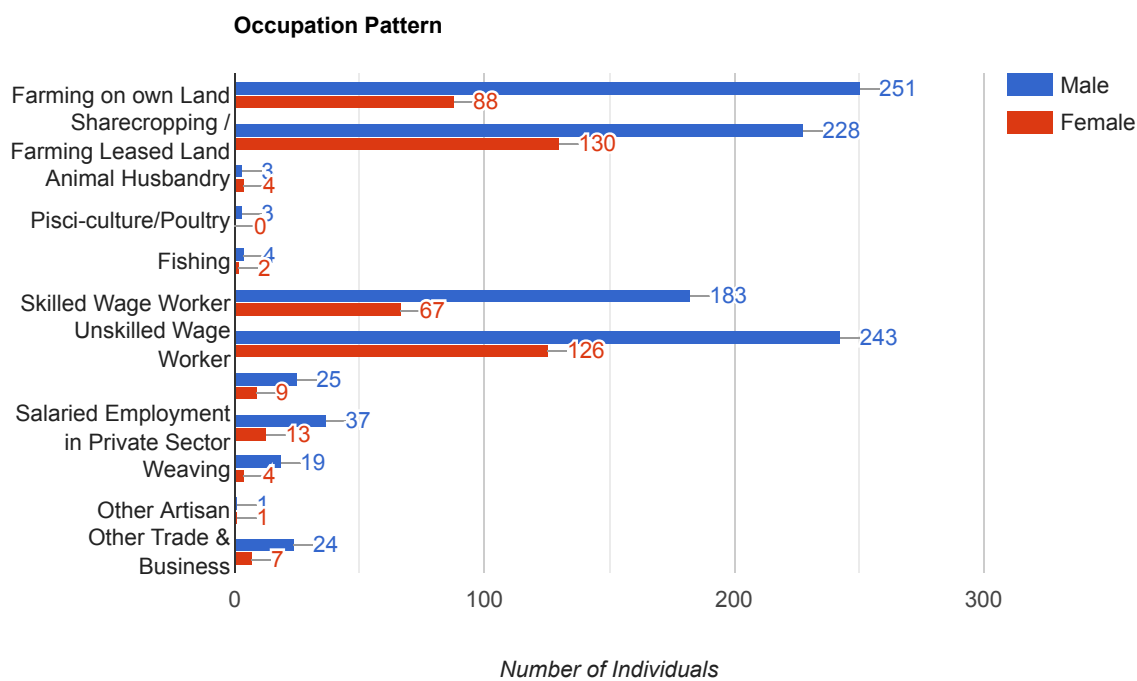

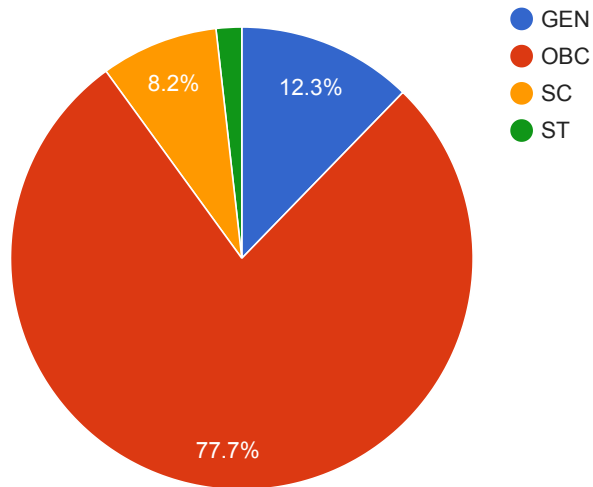

Lighting Source and usage in Village

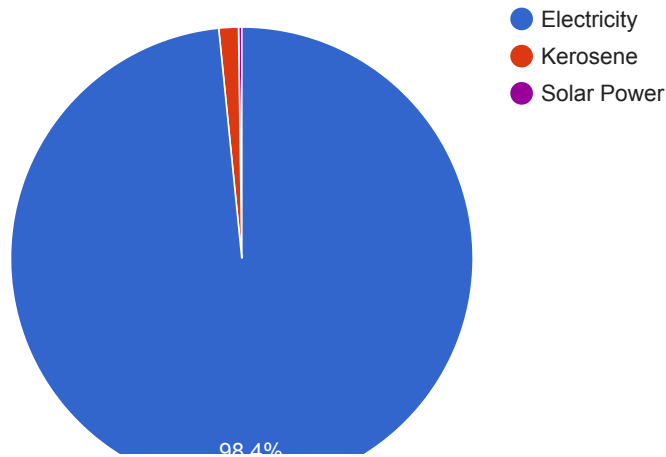

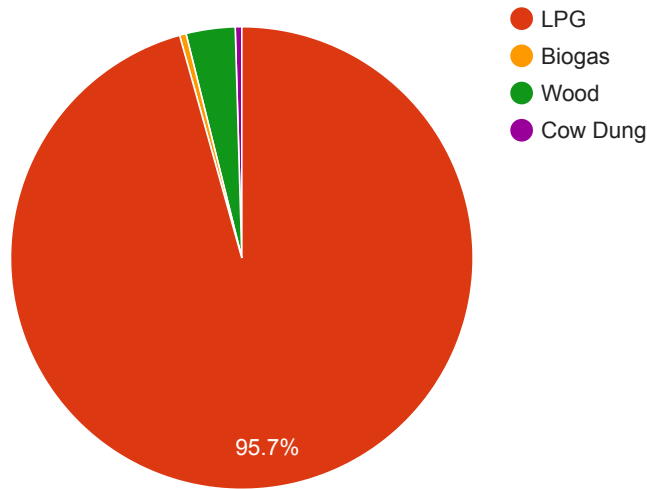

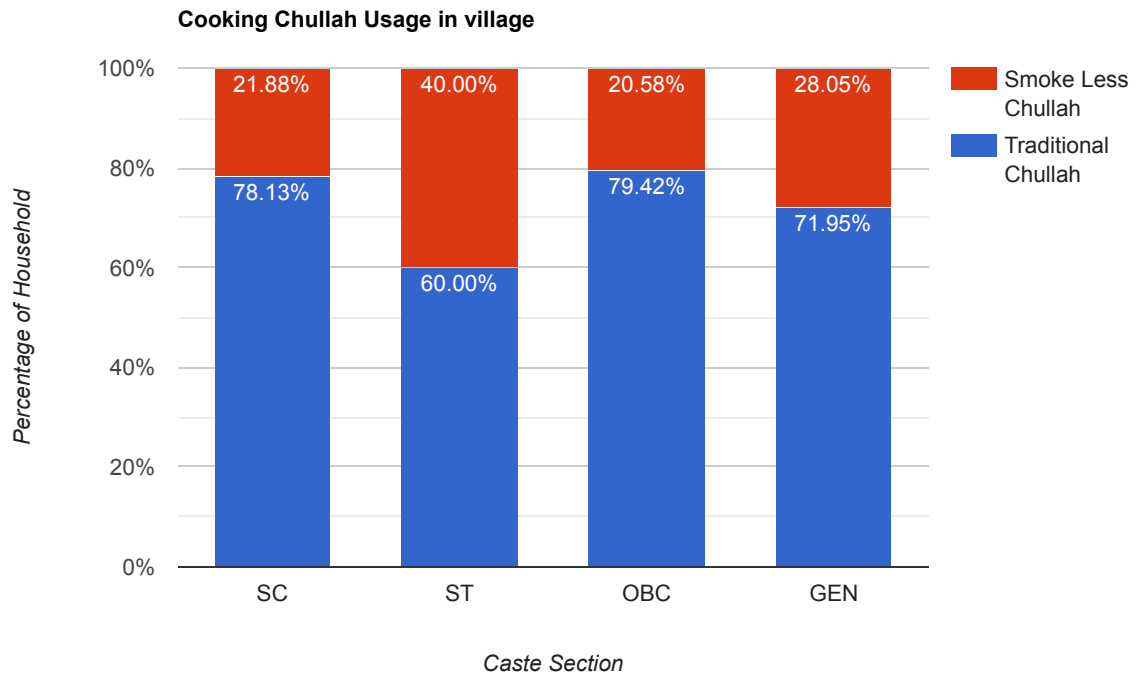

**Cooking Fuels Usage in Village**
