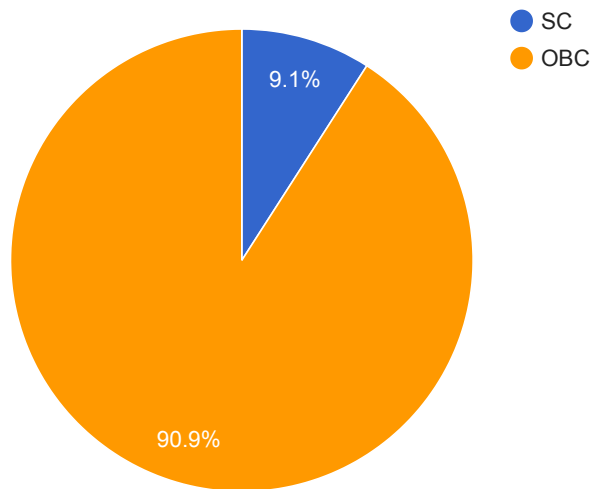

### Migration Percentage across Caste Sections



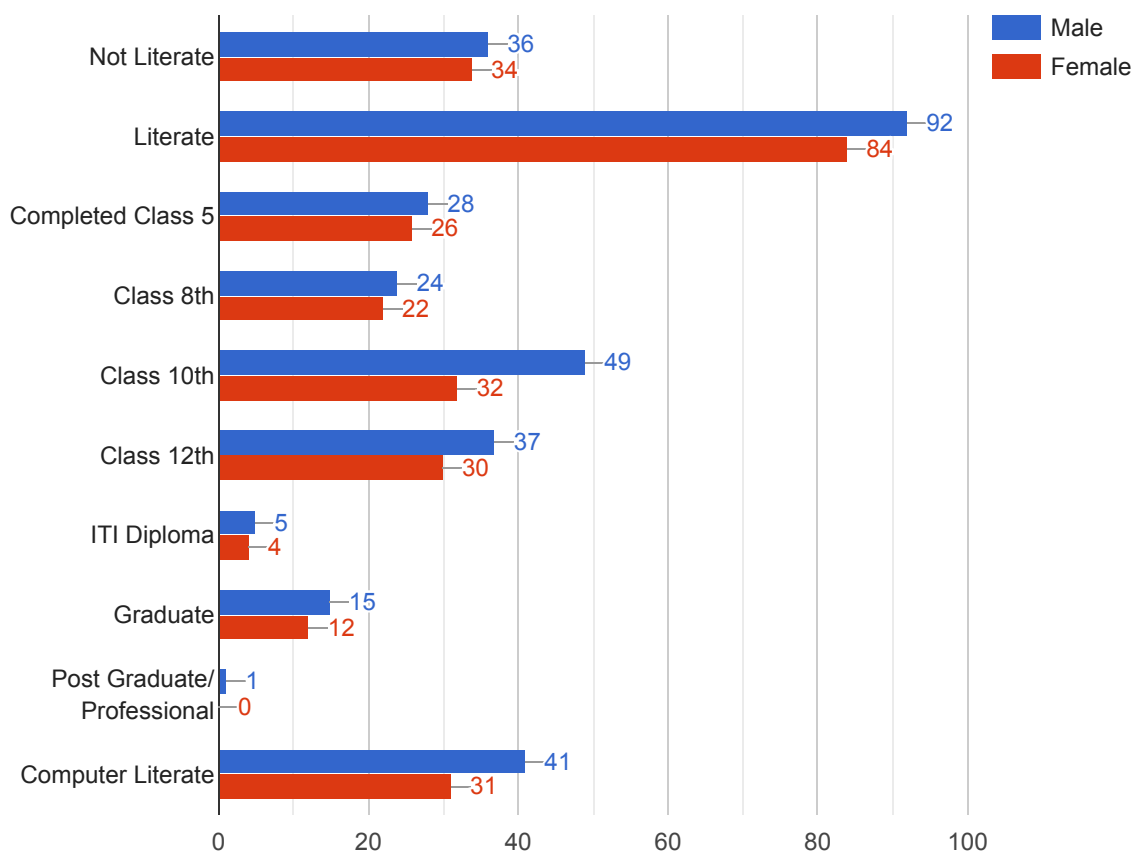

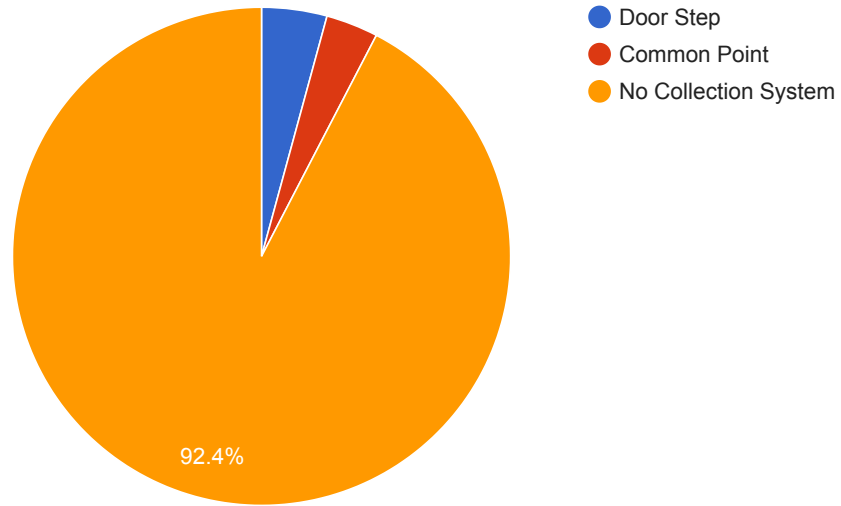

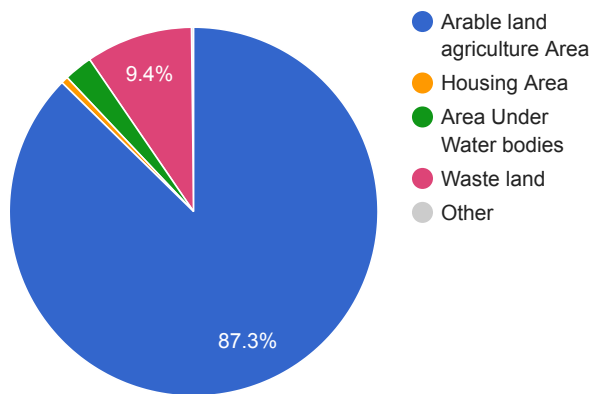

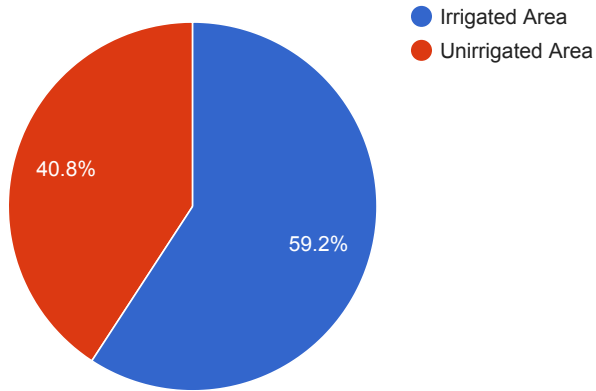

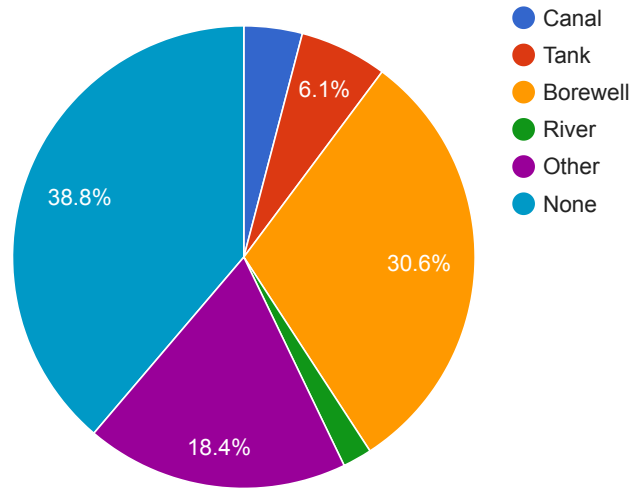

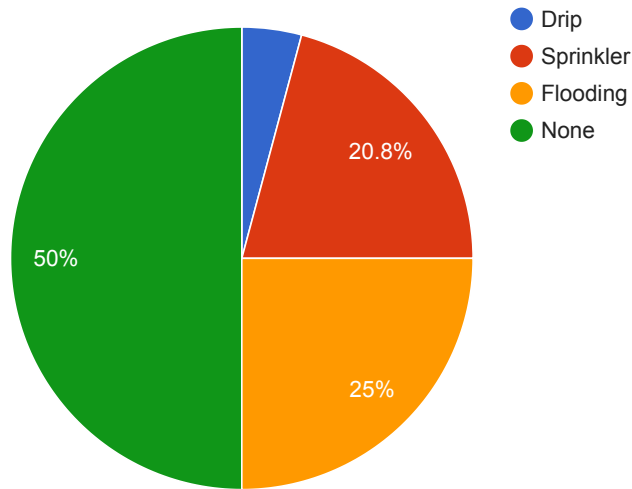

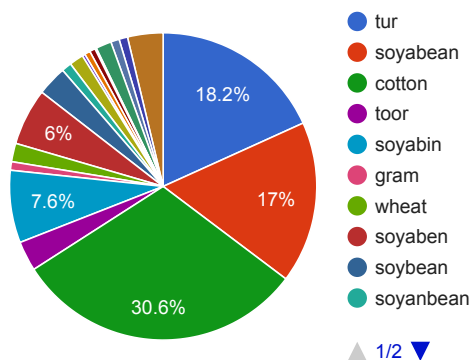

Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops

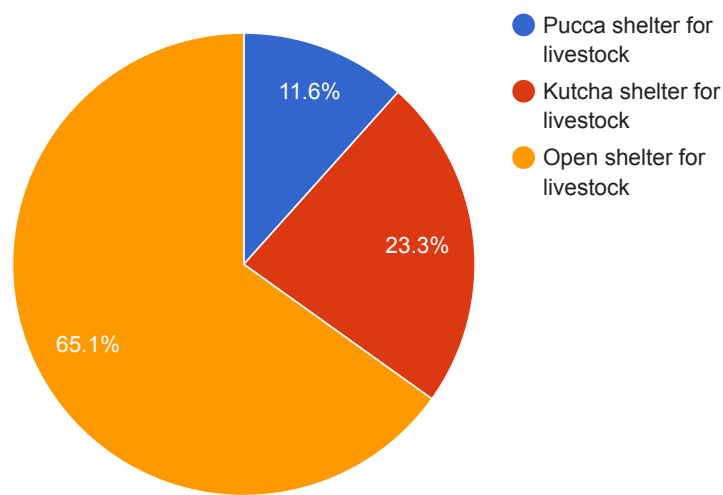

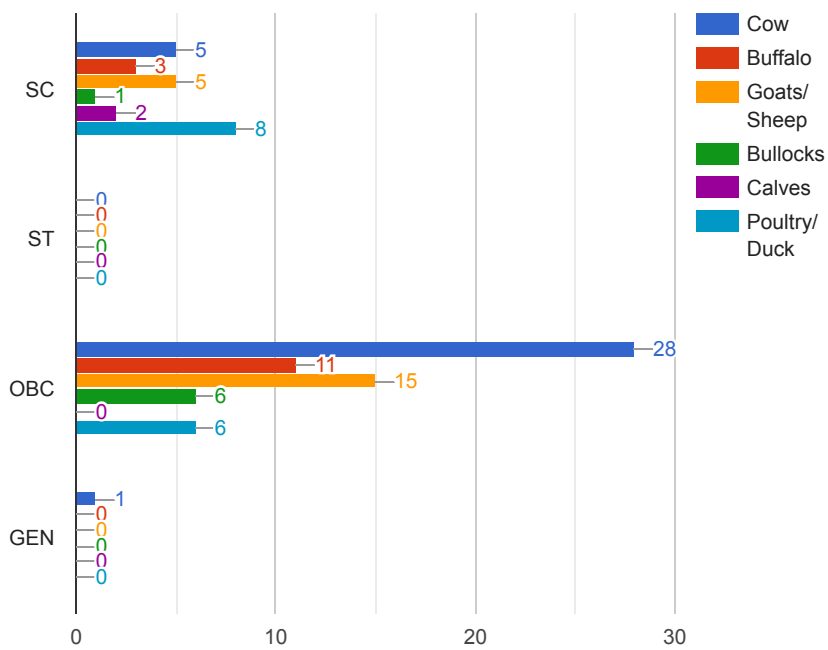

**Cattle wise population per household among various**

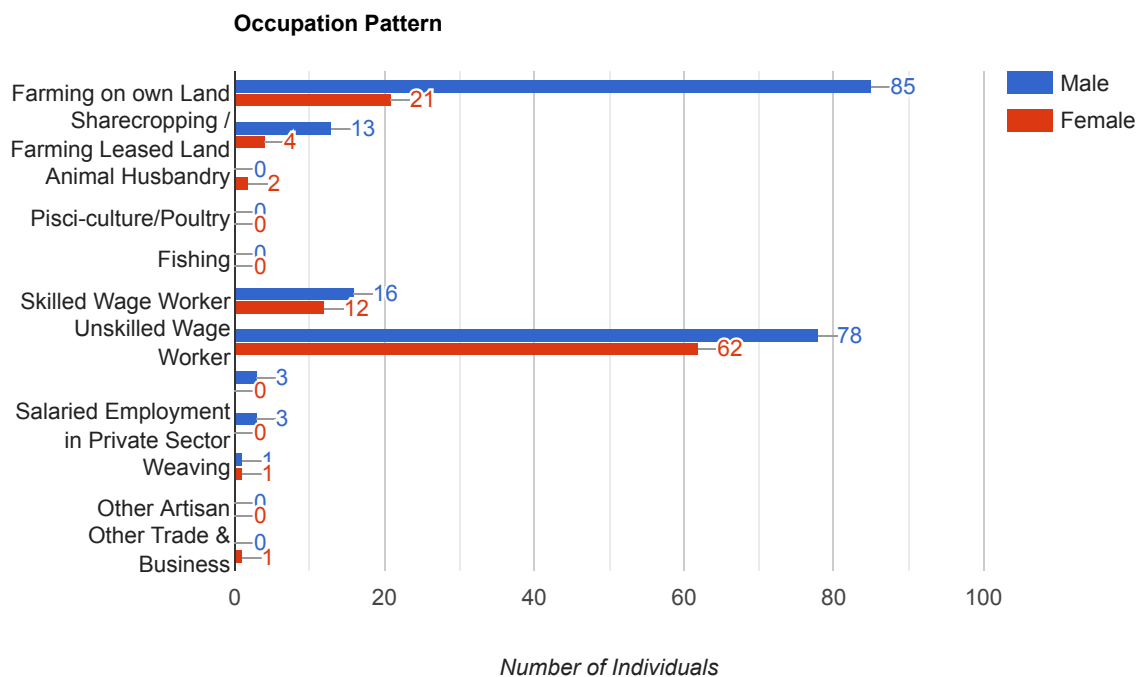

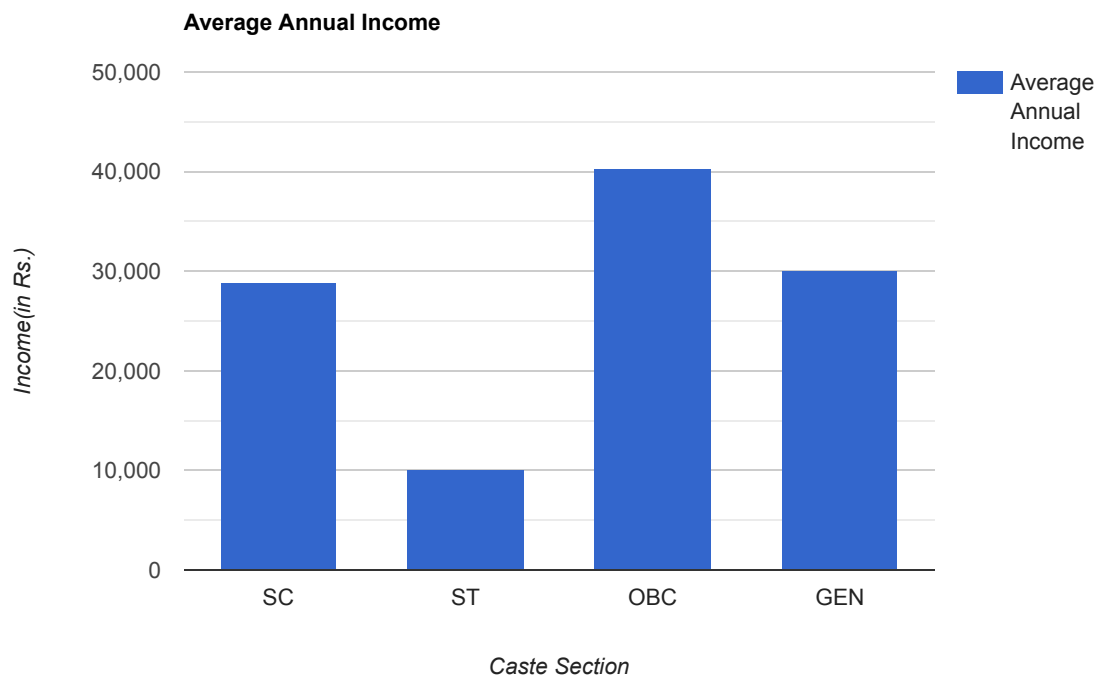

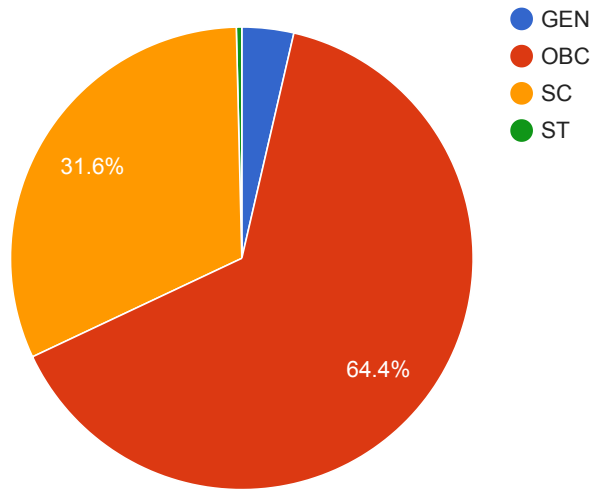

Lighting Source and usage in Village

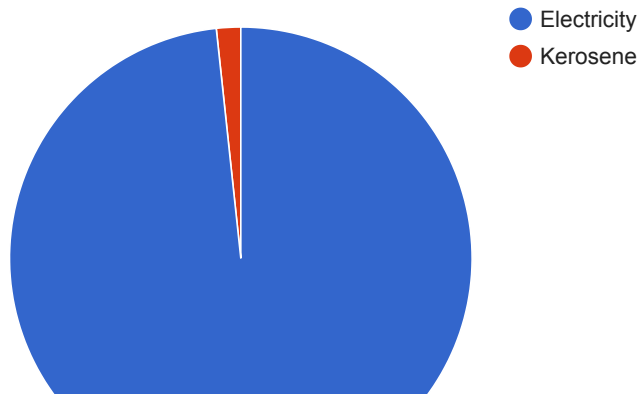

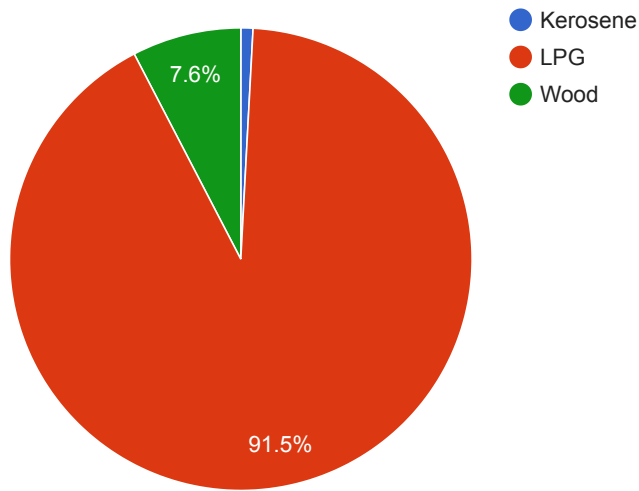
