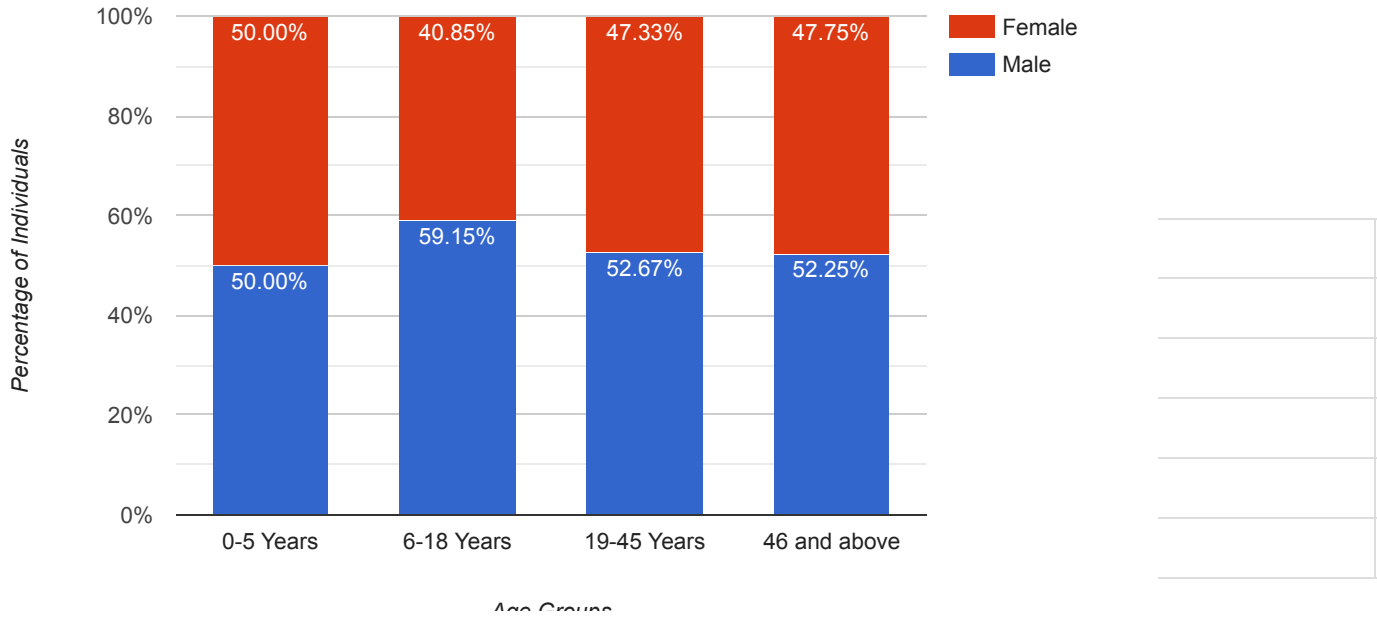

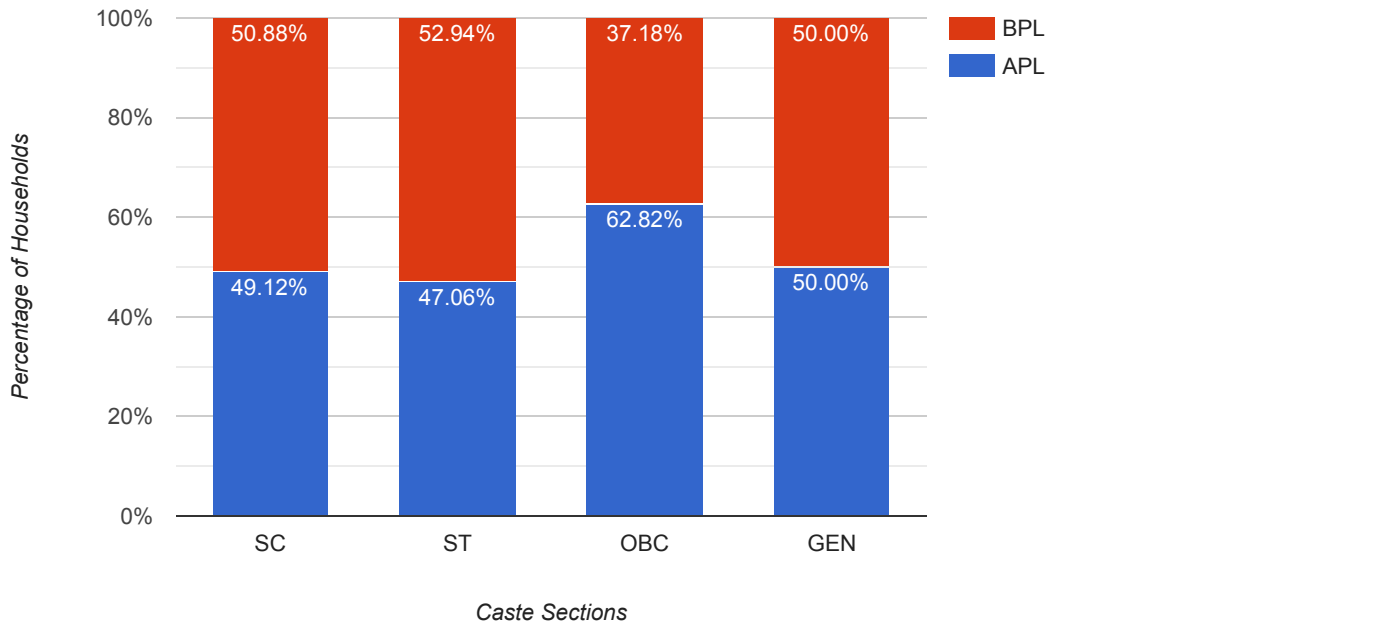

Gender Wise Population Across Age Groups



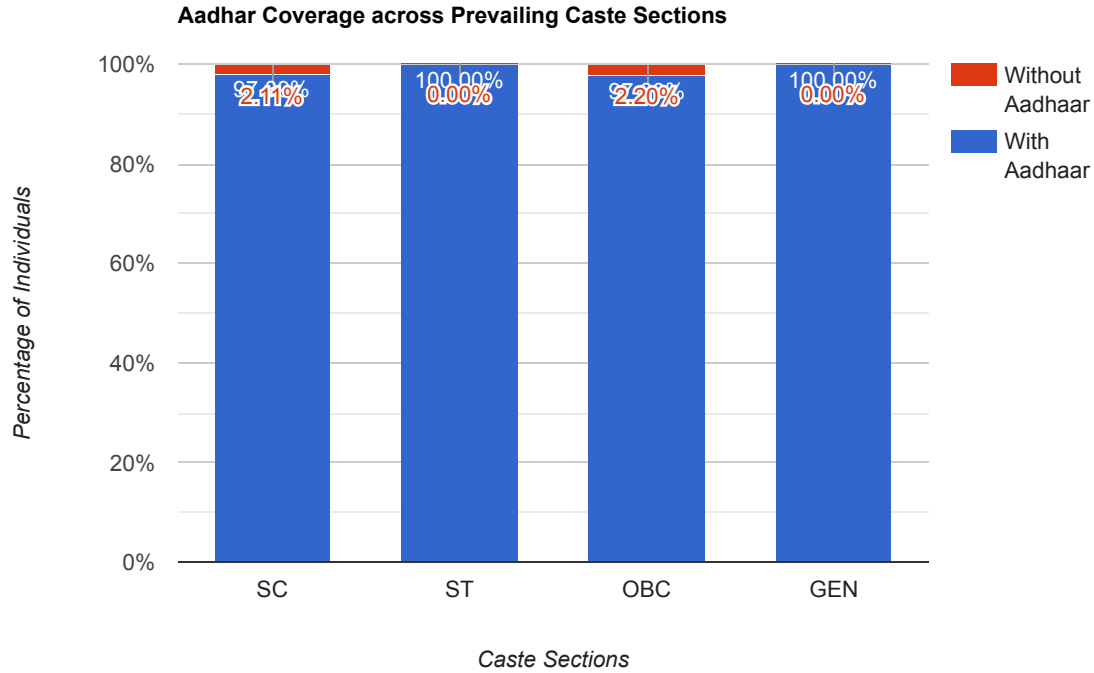
Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections

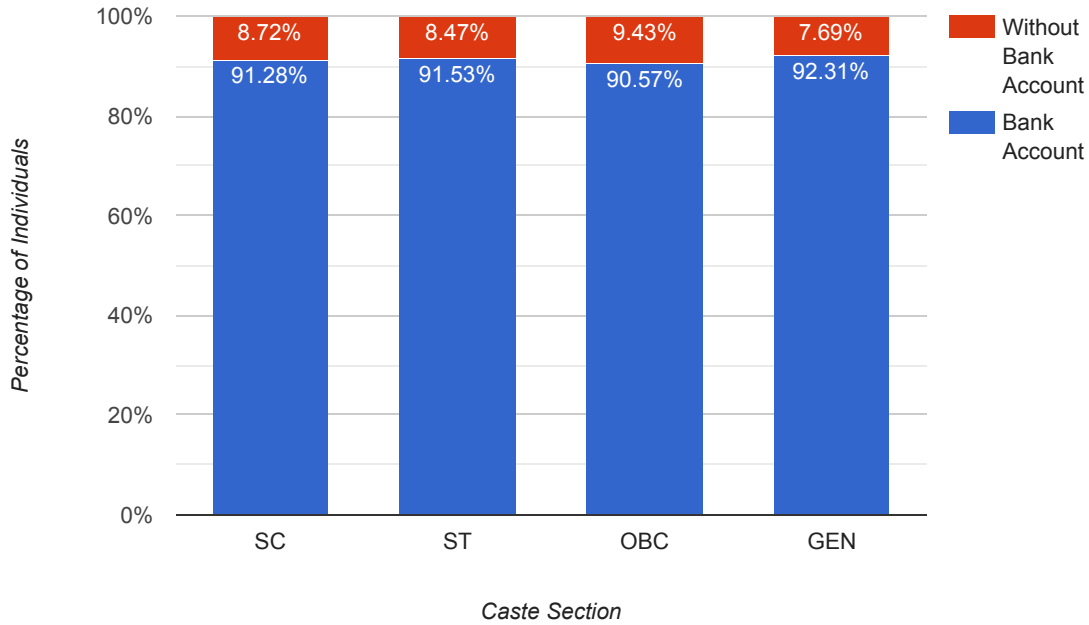

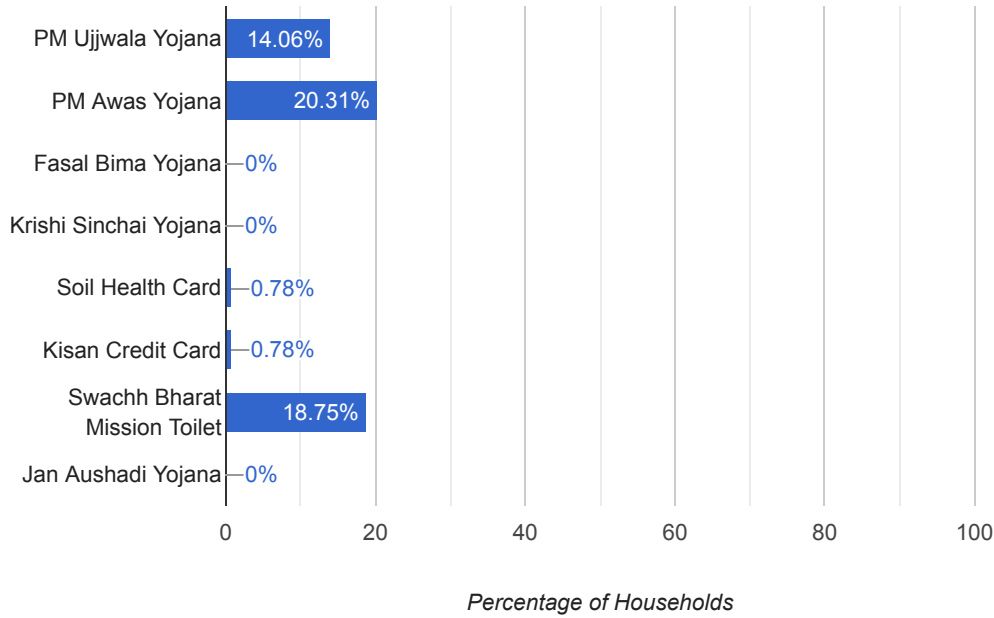

Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section



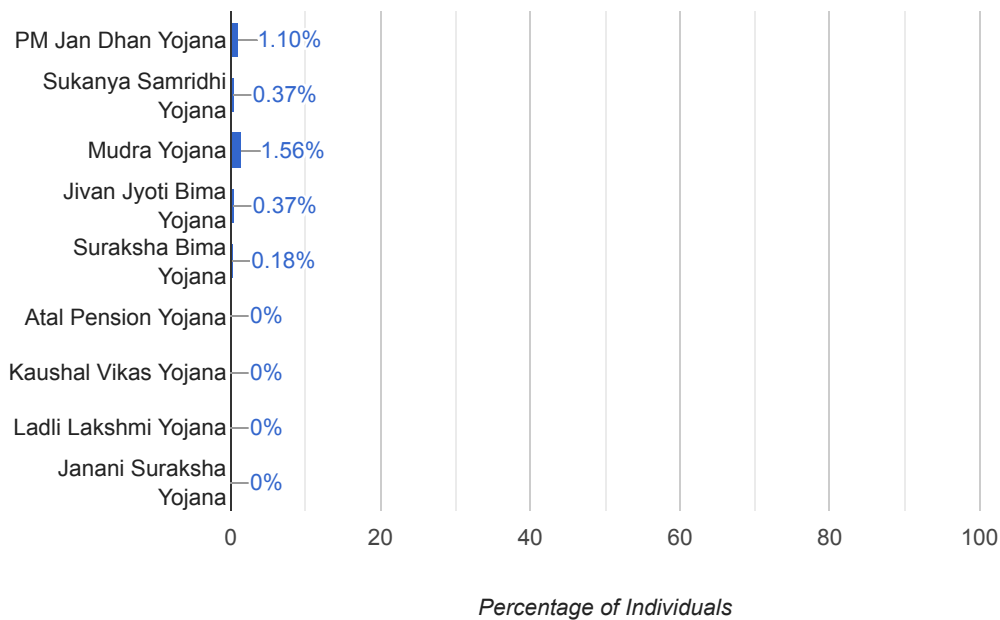

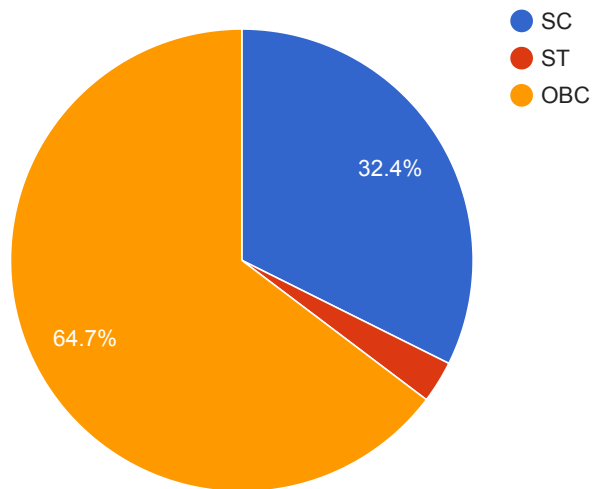

Migration Percentage across Caste Sections



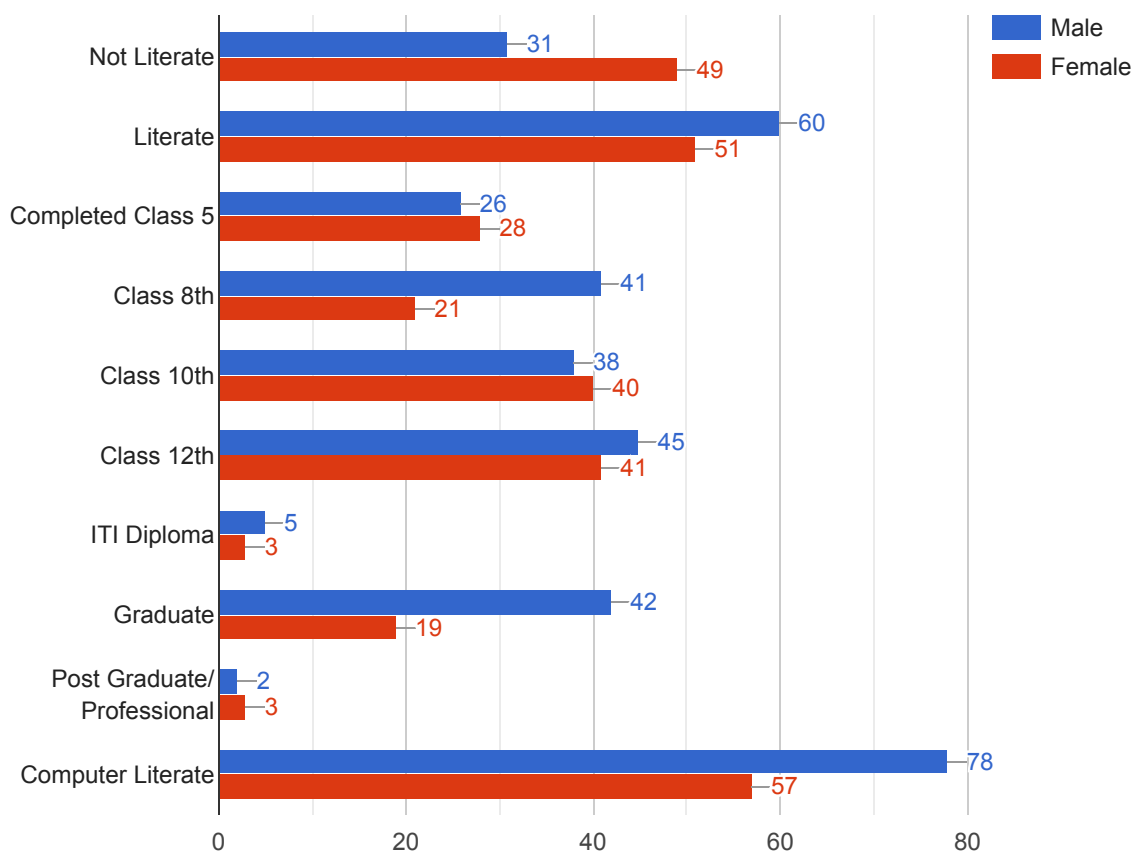

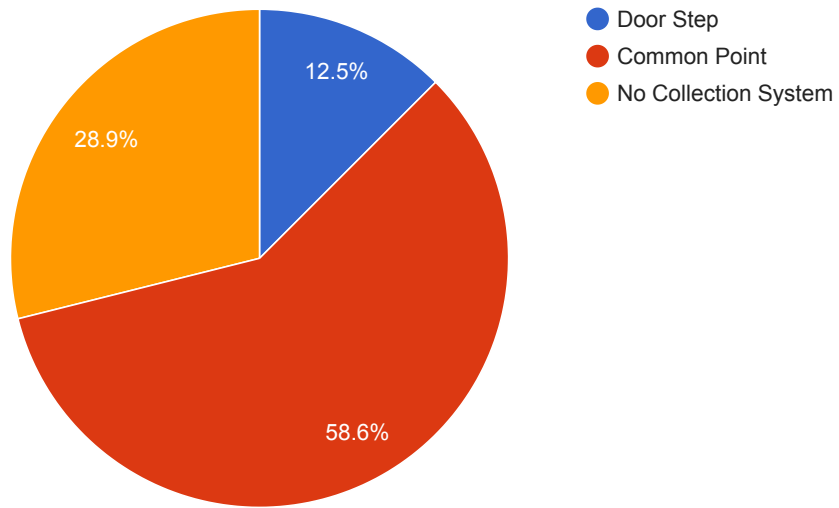

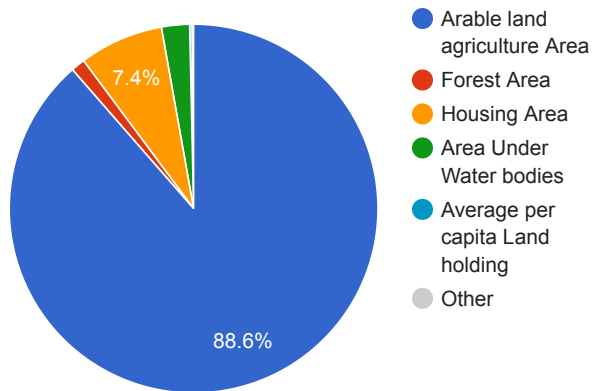

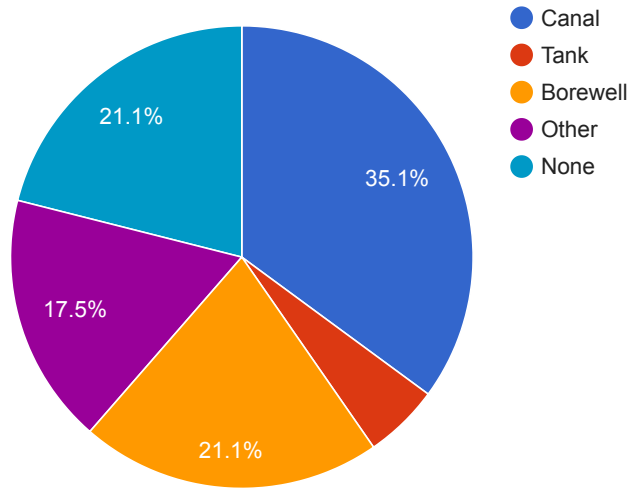
Land Use Pattern

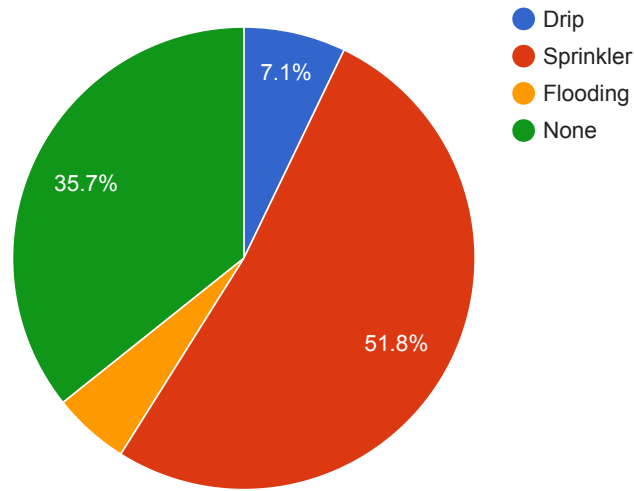
Source Wise Irrigation Coverage among then households



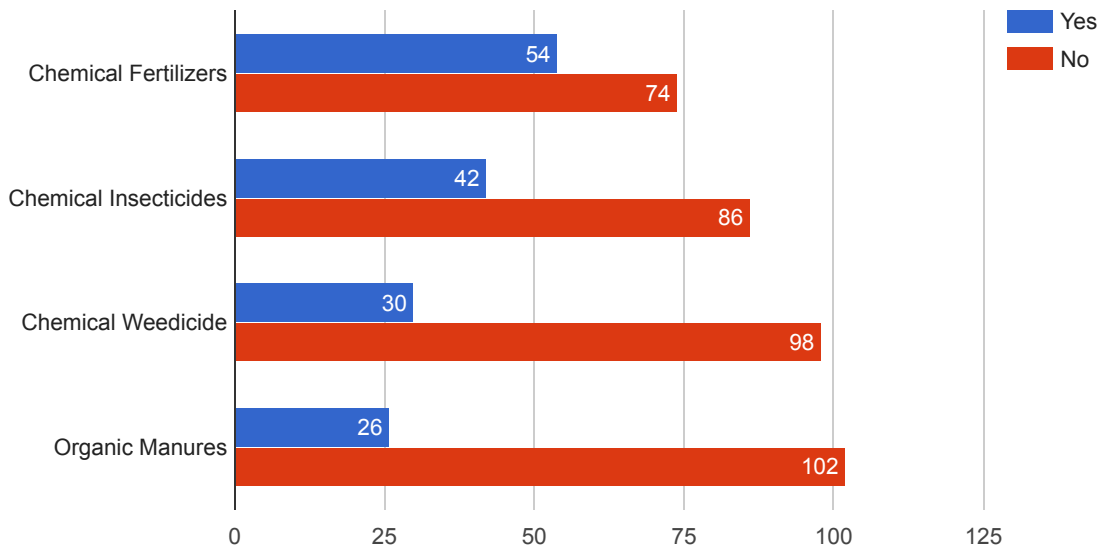

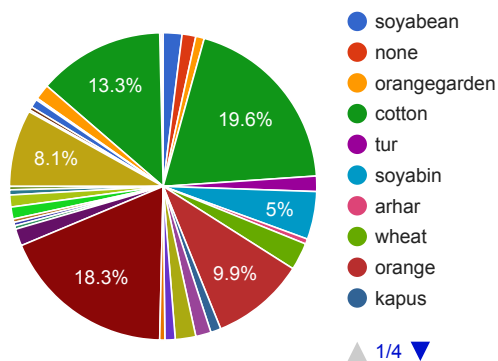
Use of Chemicals and Fertilizers



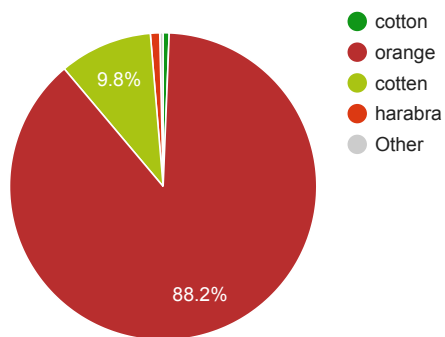

Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops

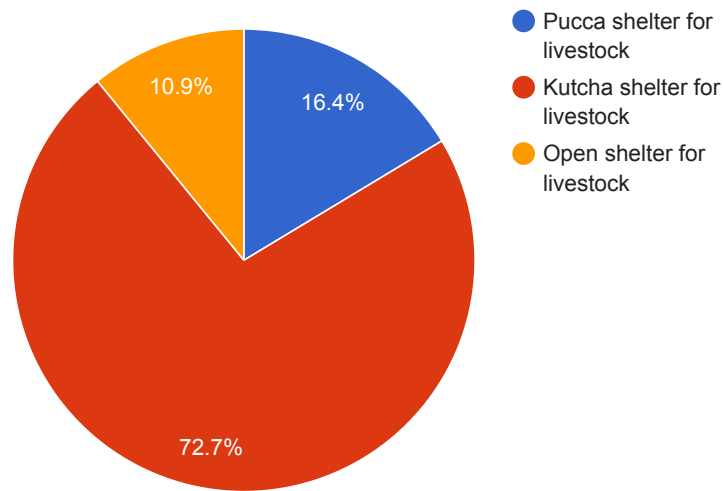

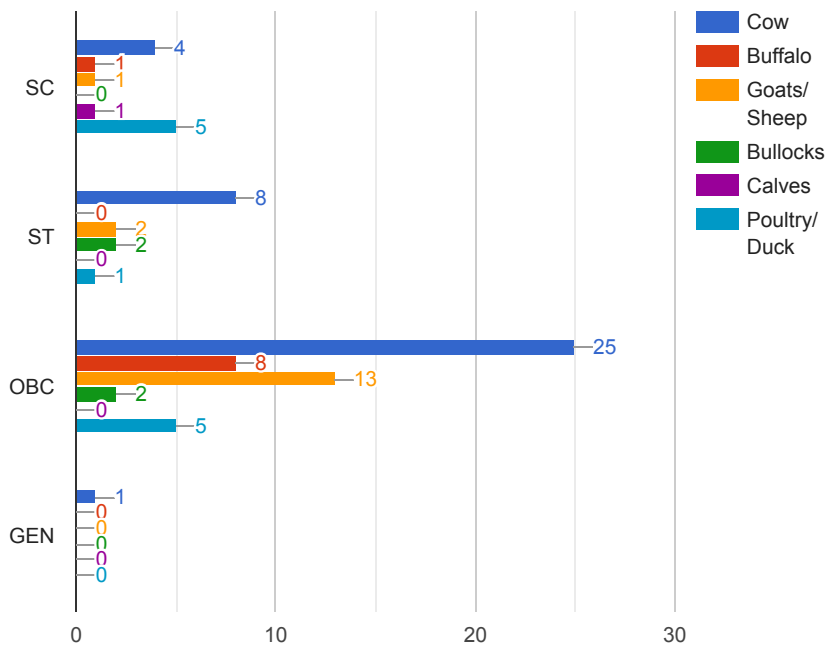

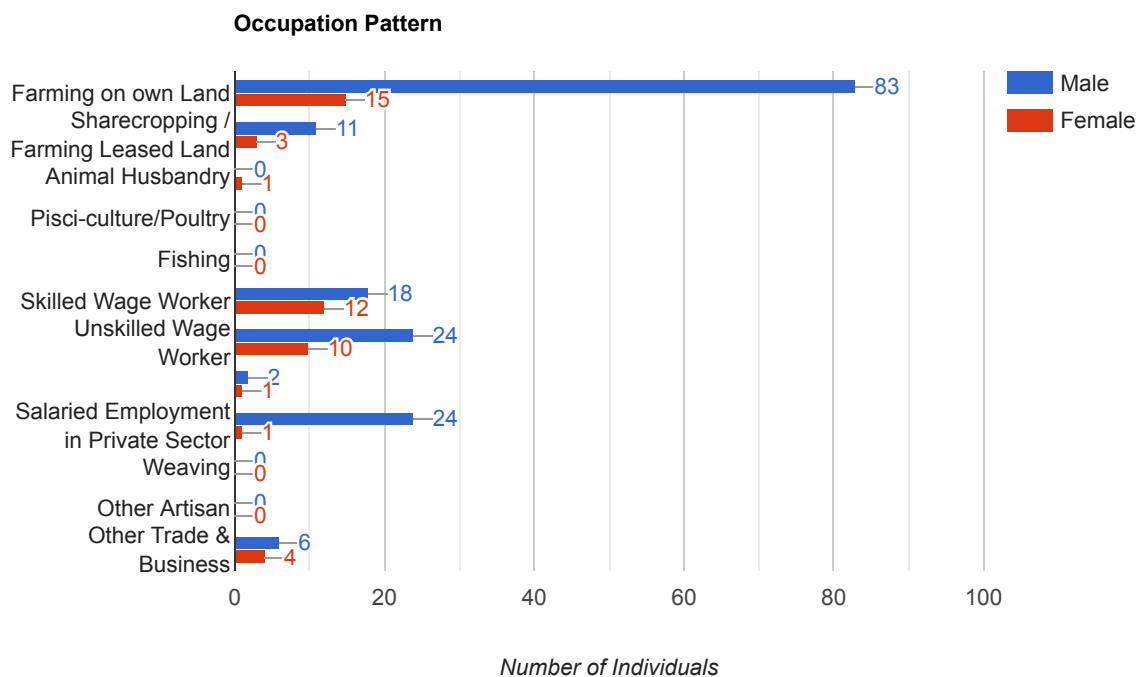

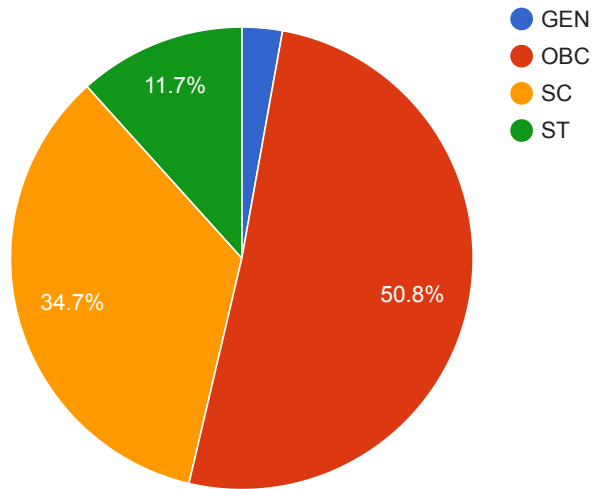

Lighting Source and usage in Village

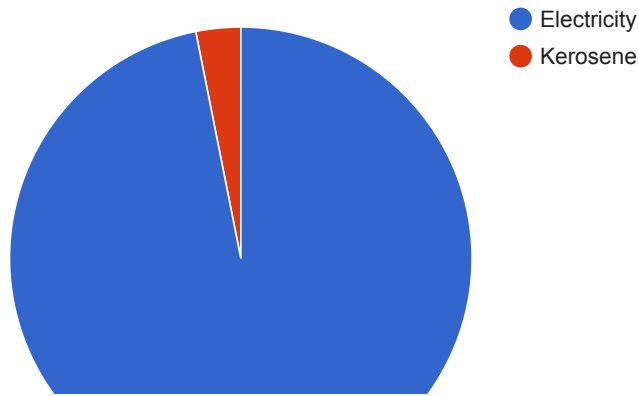

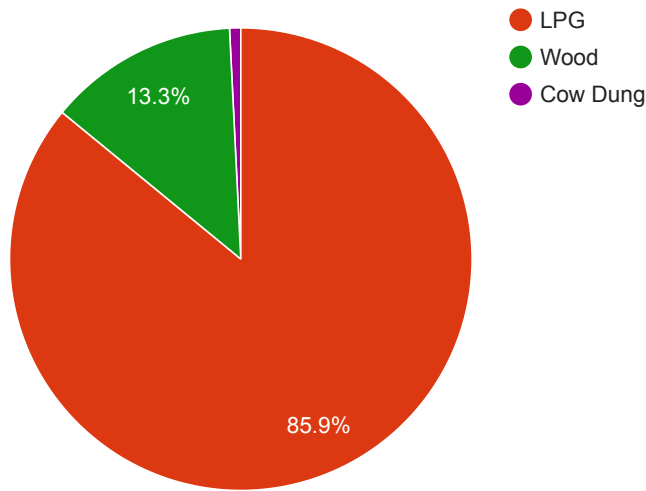
