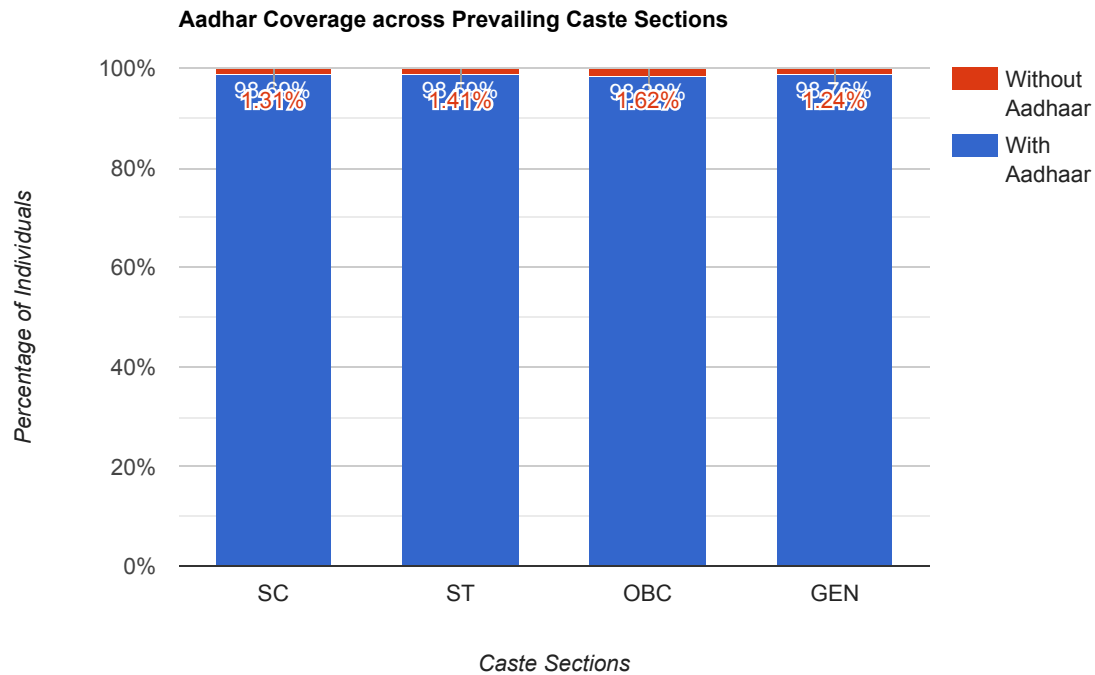

Migration Percentage across Caste Sections



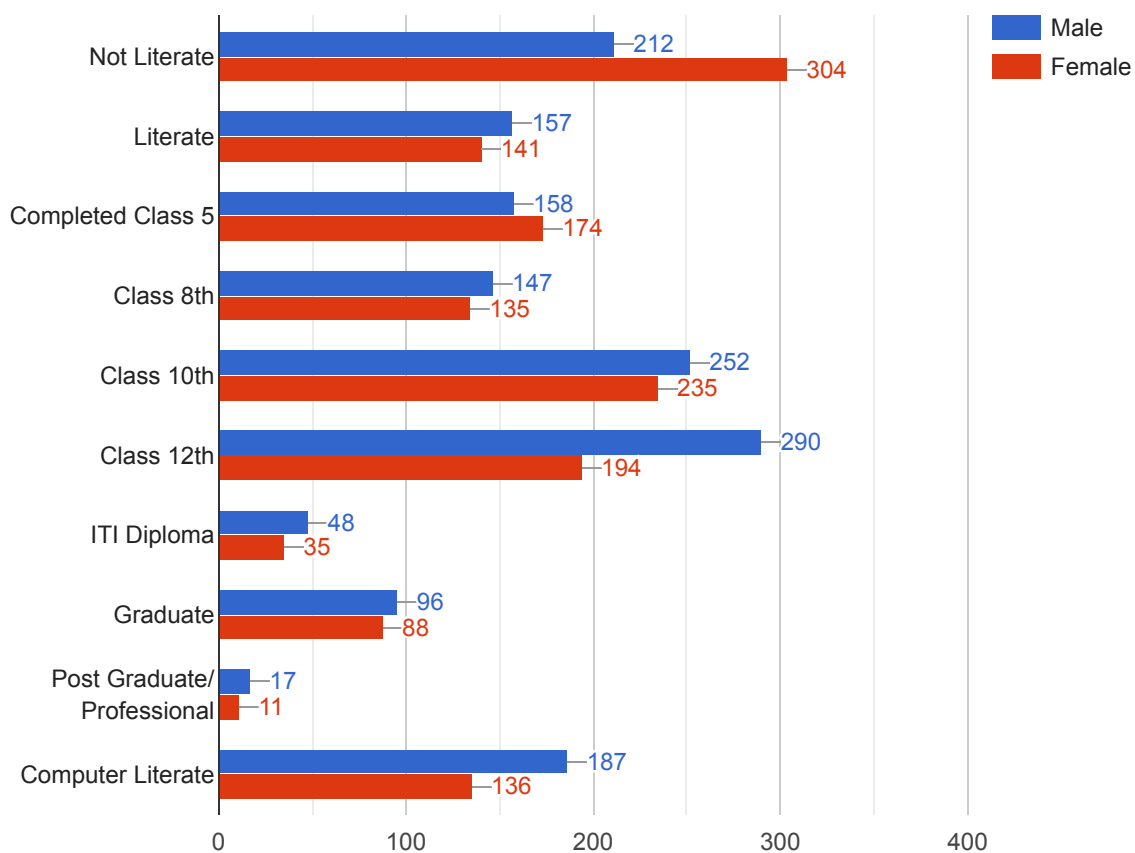

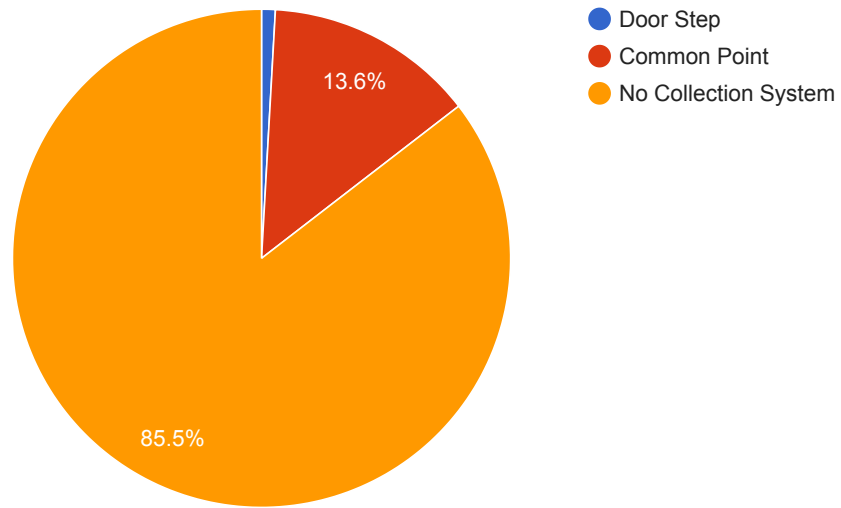

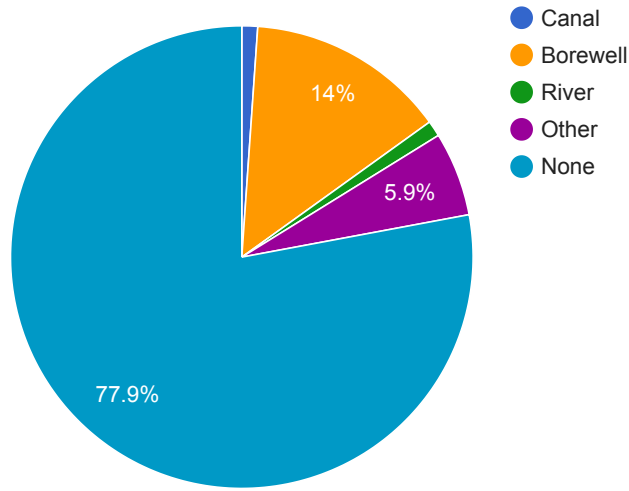
Land Use Pattern

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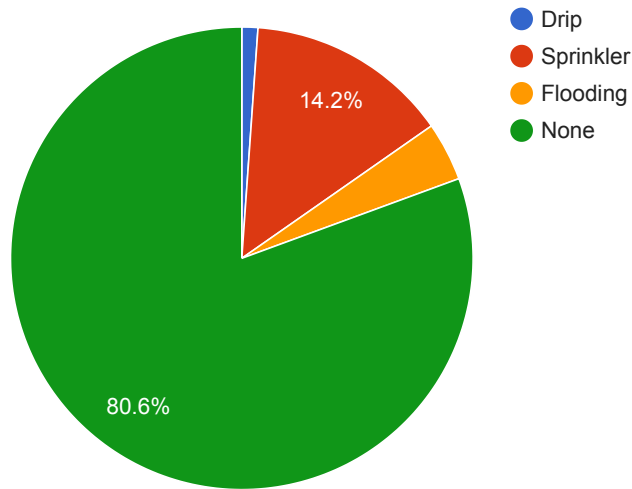
Source Wise Irrigation Coverage among then households



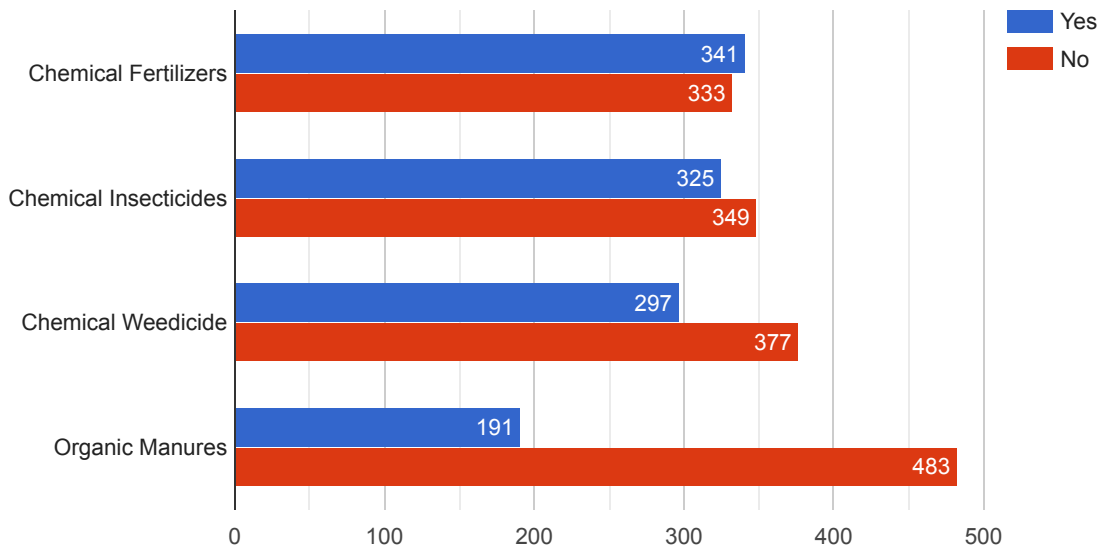

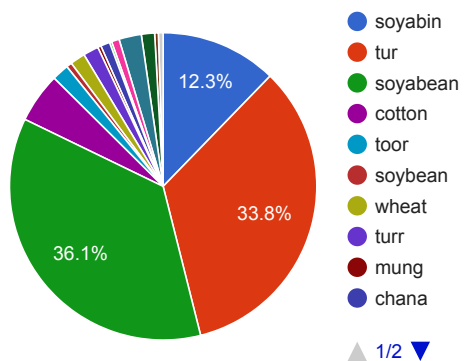

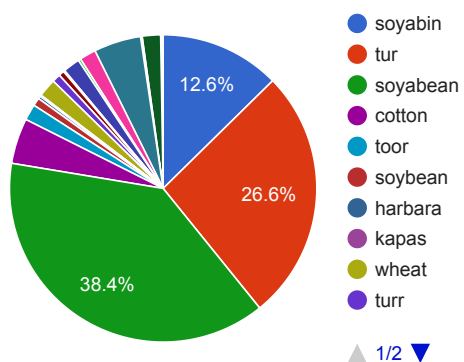

Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops

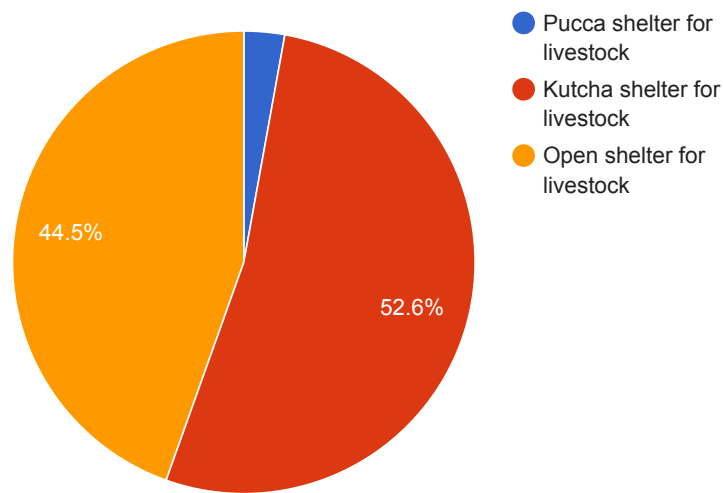

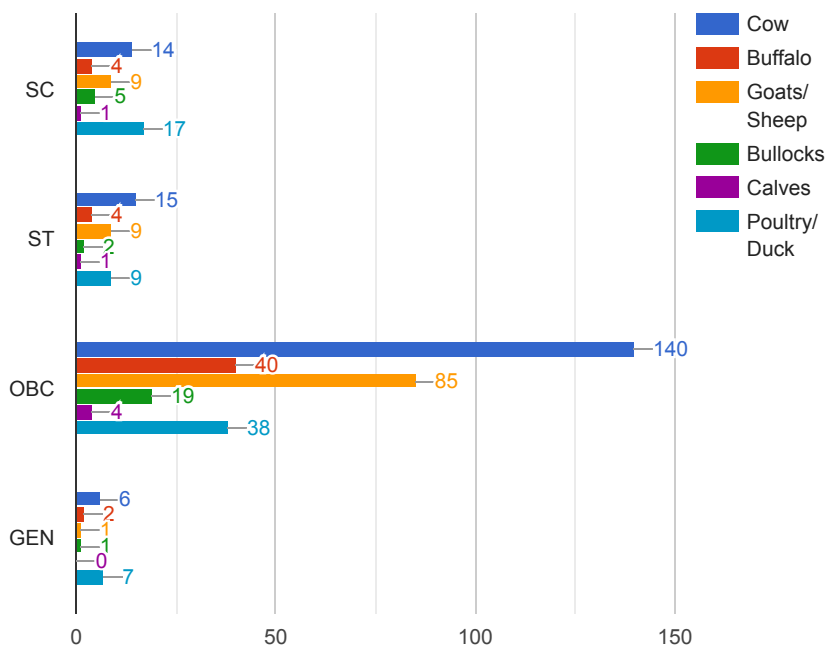

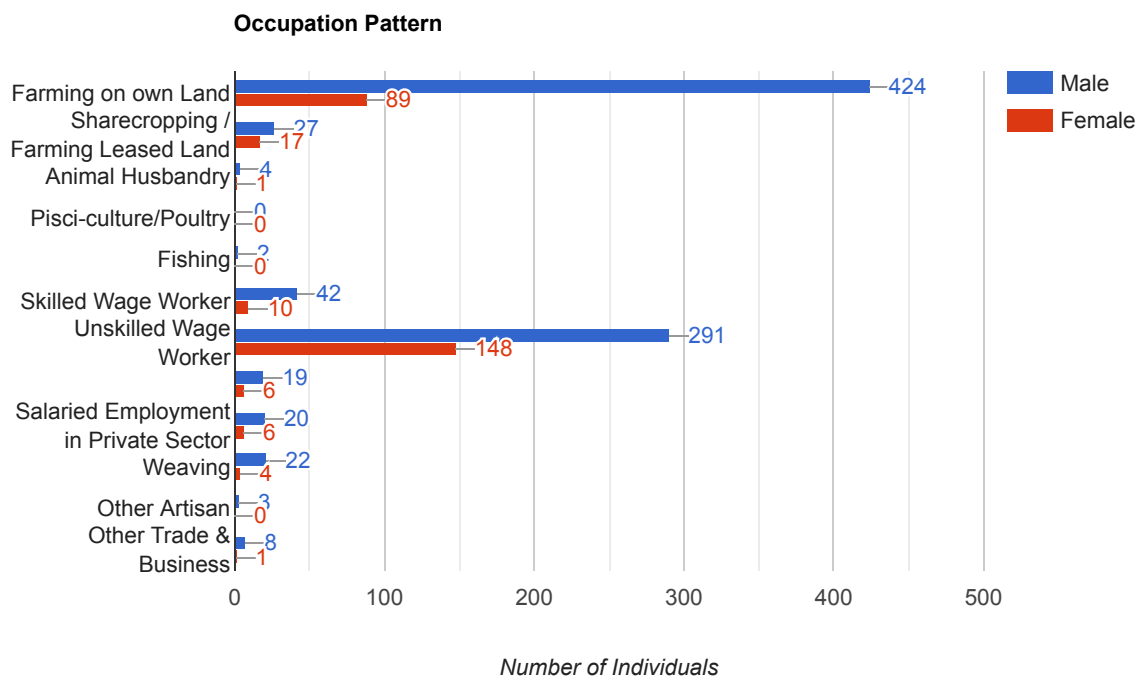

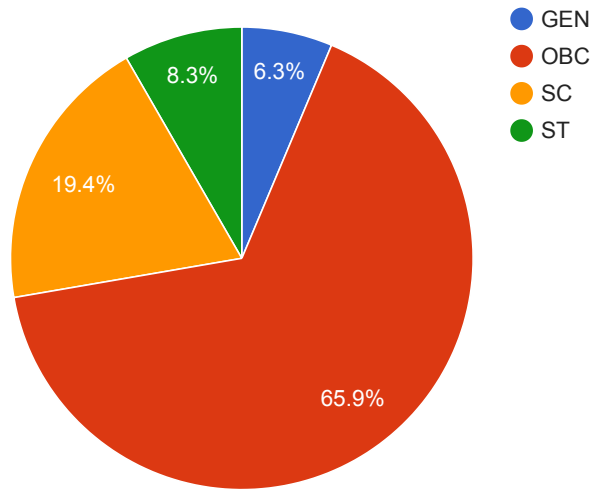

Lighting Source and usage in Village

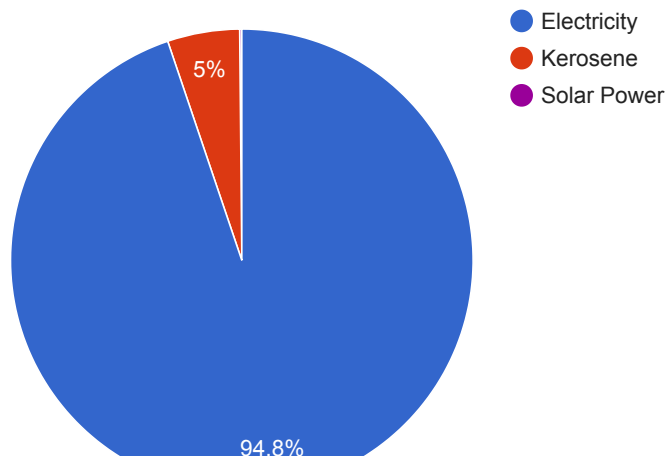

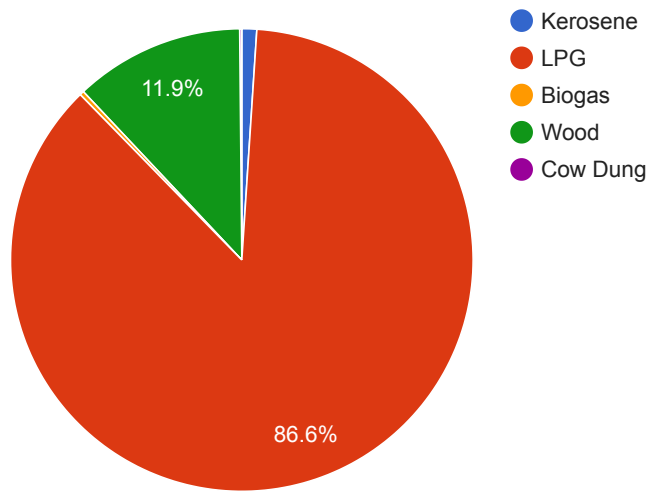

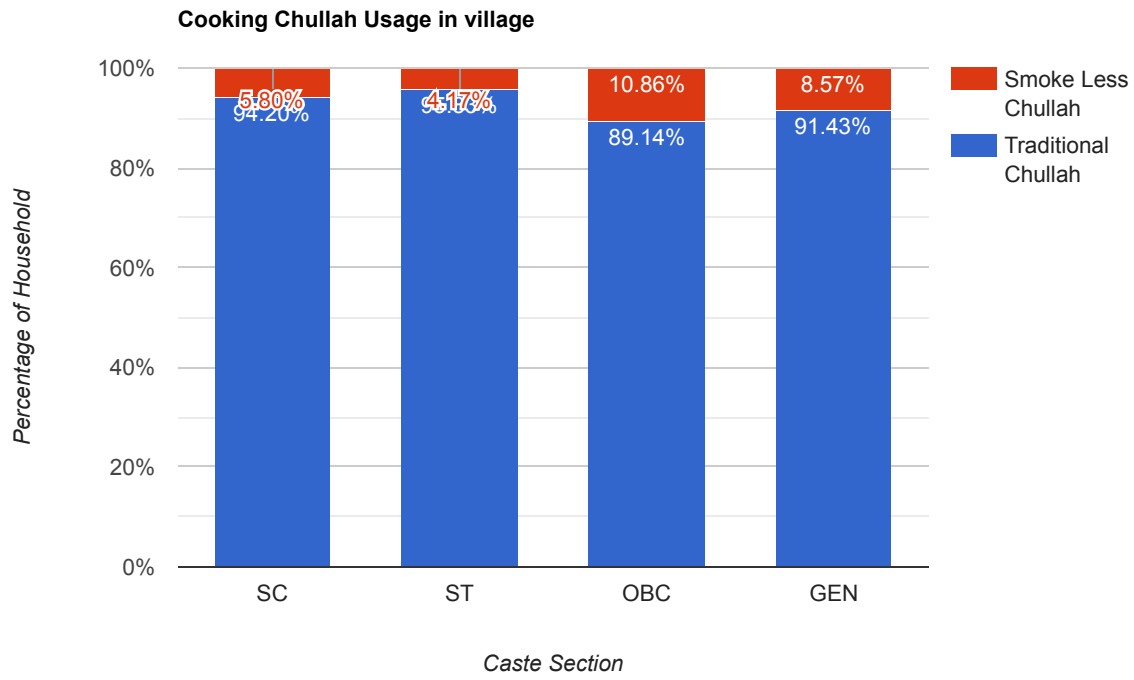
